CONTEMPORANEOUS PHILATELIC LITERATURE.

The Evergreen State Philatelist.

To issue seventy-two numbers of a philatelic monthly is more longevity than is generally meted out to philatelic papers. The Evergreen has certainly a fine record. When it first took its place among philatelic publications it was a very small paper and was ridiculed by many of the more pretentious stamp papers of that day. How many of these are now in existence?—very few. The Evergreen however, has seen far more prosperous days than it enjoys at present. Time was when it, along with the old Eastern Philatelist ranked at the very top

of collectors' papers. Now the Eastern is merged with one of the more modern papers, the Philatelic Bulletin, and the Evergreen has grown thinner besides taking a yearly siesta during the summer months. When this latter policy was adopted it seemed to me that it was an omen of the Evergreen's discrepancy and I honestly expected the paper to cease publication shortly after. It has done nothing of the kind, if anything the paper this year shows more life than last year. One good feature of it is the monthly batch of notes on U. S. stamps, by Mr. E. R. Aldrich. The staid old Veritas is another good contributor. He has stood by the paper nobly and his writings under the heading "Philately Month by Month", are very interest-

While the various sessions of the D. P. A.
