MUNICIPAL REFORM BILL.

SUMMARY.
The King has been pleased to appoint Sir John Franklin, Knt, Captain in the Royal Navy, to be Lieutenant Governor of the Island of Van Diemen's Land and its dependencies. — In the post-mortem examination of the body of General Baron Sirruch, died lately at Vienna, a nail was found which this superior officer had received thirty years before in the war of the empire. — The Queen of Madagascar has by an edict suppressed the profession of Christianity among her subjects, and strictly prohibited, on the head of religion, any departure from the customs of the ancestors. — An abstract of a new penal code for Saxony has been established. Among the punishments retained is corporal chastisement, but it is not to be inflicted to a greater extent than 33 lashes, so that the flogging in Saxony are more tenderly handled than our brave defenders in England, to whom 2000 hundred lashes may still be awarded. — At the Bristol sessions, on Monday, a gentleman claimed to be exempted from serving on the jury in consequence of having lost his right arm.
