But now, how is it? The strategic position of America lies in the North-Western States and Territories, who have sprung from the most enterprising and courageous of the Eastern youth, have resolutely determined to prohibit slavery as a constitutional amendment in the state in which they live.

In these times wheat is not the money-making crop that it used to be, but because it is a failure as to yield, but because the price has gone down to almost nothing. We still hear of 70 cents or so in Chicago, which was some years ago 10 cents below Toronto, but remember that in many western localities "wheat" is 30 or 40 cents as much as the farmers can get for it.

Mr. Wilkinson's presentation is in substance this: In the Western and Northern States some years ago the farmers got high prices for their wheat, and were full of money. (He should also have included corn, because in what are called the corn States the value of the corn crop greatly exceeds that of the wheat crop.)

At this very time up start the commercial prohibitionists, saying that the border is our natural market for all that our farmers have to sell. To which we reply: Not so, if it be true that Mr. Wilkinson says—that in the Western and Northern States the farmers suffer so much from low prices for their crops that poverty is driving them to prohibition, as a means of saving what little money they get.

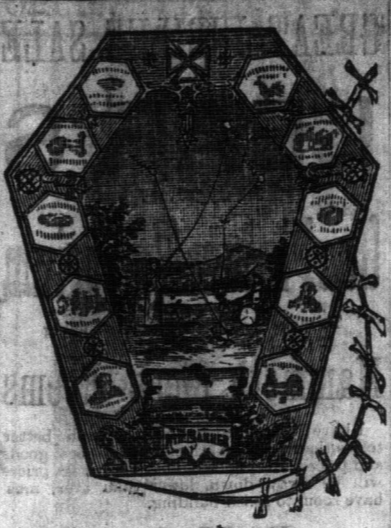

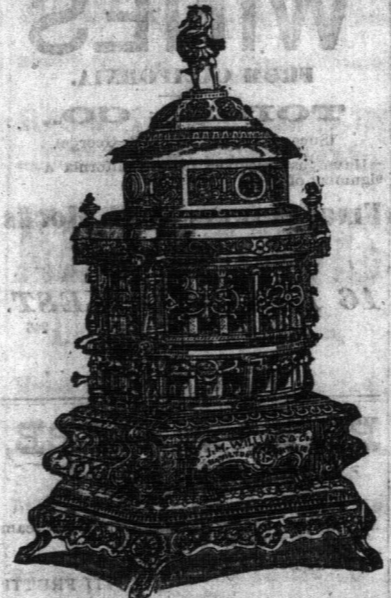
