Describes the treaty on the non-proliferation of nuclear weapons, Canada's nuclear relations and non-proliferation policy, the International Atomic Energy Agency's safeguards system and the international situation (27 pages, 14 cm x 21.6 cm).

### **Folder**

Several versions, illustrated in colour, each directed to a specific area of the world. Basic information on Canada and a description of bilateral relations and posts' addresses of relevant country or area, generally in the local language (7 panels, 9.5 cm x 21.6 cm).

### **Photosheet**

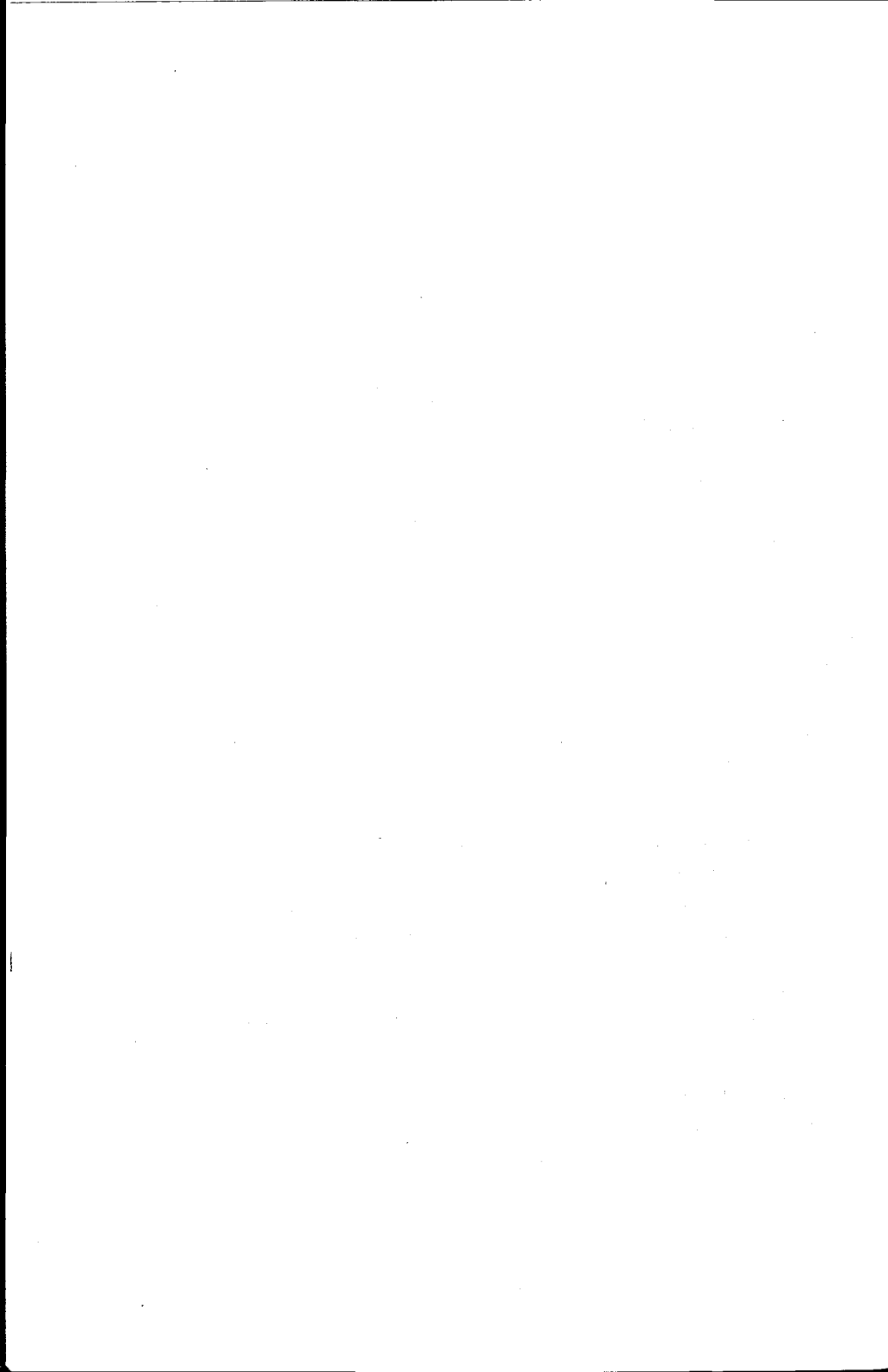
