CANADA LEADS WHOLE WORLD. Has More Railway Mileage in Proportion to Its Population.

At the end of the year 1905, according to the statistics gathered yearly by the Archiv fur Eisenbahnenwesen of Berlin, the railways operating throughout the world aggregated 582,783 miles in length and represented a capital of more than \$40,000,000,000.
