SIXTY-THIRD ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT
OF THE
ST. GEORGE'S SOCIETY
OF TORONTO,
FOR THE YEAR 1897.

The year having passed for which the present Officers were elected, it becomes their duty to present this their Annual Report.

And it is with regret that the Committee have to reiterate the statement previously made, that the labour market in Toronto still continues in a very depressed condition ; it being utterly impossible to find employment for the number of young, able-bodied men, married and single, that are in, and continue to flock to, Toronto. Consequently, there has been a large number of applicants for relief.

RECEIPTS.

The total receipts from all sources, including the balance of \$177.88 from last year, amounts to \$2,562.94.

The receipts from the Ordinary Members and newly elected Life Members are about the same as the previous year, but there is a decrease in the receipts from the investments, while the donations to the funds of the Society exceed previous years.

The receipts for the Christmas Distribution were \$984.00.

RELIEF.

During the year 1,275 applicants have been relieved.

The amount expended on relief has been \$809.31, which is considerable in advance of last year. Orders for graves in our plot in St. James' Cemetery have been given for twelve adults and four children.

MEMBERSHIP.

There have been 12 Life Members elected during the year, and 20 Ordinary Members.

ANNIVERSARIES, ENTERTAINMENTS, ETC.

The usual Anniversary Service was held in St. James' Cathedral, on the afternoon of Sunday, April 25th. The Rev. Provost Welch, Chaplain of the Society, preached an eloquent sermon, and the musical portion of the service was exceptionally well rendered under the able direction of the late Dr. Stocks Hammond.

CONCERT IN THE PAVILION.

On the evening of the 25th of March a Concert was given in the Pavilion in the Horticultural Gardens, by the Ladies' Choral Society, under the direction of Mr. E. W. Schuch, who very kindly volunteered his services. It was well attended, and much enjoyed by those present.

ANNUAL DINNER.

The Annual Dinner was held in the Society's hall, on the evening of April 24th. There was a good attendance of members, and a jovial time was enjoyed.

QUEEN'S DIAMOND JUBILEE CELEBRATION.

On the 22nd day of June it may be said occurred the great event of the year, as the sixtieth year of Her Majesty's reign took place. A large procession, in which the Society took a prominent part, formed in the Queen's Park, and proceeded thence to the Exhibition Grounds. The Society's appearance was enhanced by two handsome silk flags (the Union Jack and St. George's Cross) generously donated by 1st Vice-Pres. G. H. Gooderham, and used for the first time on this occasion.

SMOKING CONCERTS.

There were two Smoking Concerts held during the year, in the Society's hall, on the evenings of March 15th and October 19th. Both were well attended, and served their purpose of promoting sociability amongst our members.

For the past three winters those members of the Society who are curlers have played a friendly game with the Scotch members of the combined rinks, and in the game last March for the THIRD time came out victorious ; thus adding to the Society's benefit (in shape of several bags of flour). The thanks of the Society are due to the courtesy of the members of the Granite Rink in placing the ice at their disposal, and also to the doughty players who participated therein. Those who were present will long remember the pleasant and enjoyable evenings spent

While there has been somewhat of an improvement in the attendance of members at the monthly meetings during the year, it has been too small altogether, considering the large membership, and it is earnestly requested that more interest should be taken in the Society's affairs, and encouragement given to the Committee and Officers who spend much time and energy in conducting its business.

The Life Membership fees for the years 1896-7 were invested, according to By-law, in a Western Canada Loan Co. debenture.

It was decided to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee year by providing new medals for the President and Vice-Presidents.

The regular Christmas distribution to the English poor was held in St. George's Hall on the day before Christmas, and was honoured by a visit from His Excellency the Governor-General and Lady Aberdeen. Their Excellencies were received by the President and Officers in the hall, where also were assembled a large number of the poor, and the hearty reception accorded by them to their Excellencies, together with the singing of the National Anthem, were features of the distribution that will long be remembered by those present. 741 families (or about 3,950 persons) received substantial Christmas cheer, there being distributed 7,445 lbs. of beef, 1,250 four-pound loaves of bread, 3 barrels of sugar, 2 chests of tea, and other groceries.

In conclusion, your Committee desire to state that the past season has been a very busy one, and at times the drain upon our resources has been extremely heavy, but the liberal donations of firm supporters have enabled us to carry out the objects of the Society so far as lay in our power.
