An Act to abolish Wards in Townships, and to make Reeves and Deputy Reeves elective by the direct vote of the people in Upper Canada.

HEREAS it is expedient to abolish wards in townships, and to Preamble. provide for the election of Reeves and Deputy Reeves in the several townships, towns, and incorporated villages in Upper Canada, by a direct vote of the electors; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with 5 the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 1. All wards heretofore established and now existing in the several Wards townships in Upper Canada, are abolished, and all by-laws establishing abolished. the same are hereby repealed.
- 2. Whenever a township is divided into electoral divisions, and poll-nomination ing places established therein, and Returning Officers established therefore day of for, under and by virtue of the provisions of the two hundred and election, of seventy-fifth section of chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes Reeves. for Upper Canada, a meeting of the electors of such township shall be 15 held on the last Monday but one in the month of December before the annual municipal election as provided by the said Act, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, for the nomination of a Reeve and four Councillors, or if the Township be entitled to a Deputy Reeve, for the nomination of a Reeve, Deputy Reeve, and three Councillors, to be elected for the 20 said township, and such meeting shall be held at the Town Hall if there be one in the said township; but if there be no Township Hall, then at the place where the first meeting of the Council of the said Township Where held, was held for the then current year; and the Township Clerk shall give and by whom the notice required by section ninety-seven of chapter fifty-four of the called.

- 3. The Township Clerk shall preside at such meeting, or in case of who shall his absence through sickness or otherwise, the Council shall appoint a preside at person to preside in his place, and if the Township Clerk or the person such meeting, so appointed does not attend, the electors present shall choose from among themselves, a chairman, being an elector, to officiate.
 - 4. Such Township Clerk, or person so appointed, or chairman so His powers: chosen, shall, with respect to such meeting, have all the powers of a Returning Officer.
- 5. If, at such meeting, only one person be nominated for the office If there be of Reeve or Deputy Reeve, and only the requisite number of persons only the required for councillors, within one hour of the opening of the meeting, ber of candidates.

They shall be then the person or persons so nominated for any of these offices respectively shall be declared by the chairman duly elected to serve as Reeve, Deputy-Reeve, or Councillors, as the case may be.

- 6. In all cases where more than one person shall be nominated for the office of Reeve or Deputy Reeve, or where more than the requisite number for any office.

 The office of Reeve or Deputy Reeve, or where more than the requisite number of persons required to fill the office of Councillors shall be nominated, the Township Clerk or chairman of the meeting shall, on the following day, post up in the office of the clerk of the municipality the names of the persons proposed for the respective offices for which a 10 contestation is to take place; and shall provide the Returning Officer or Officers with a certified list of the names of such Candidates, specifying the offices for which they are respectively candidates.

 10. The Township Clerk or person so appointed, or chairman so chosen as aforesaid, shall add up the votes set down for each candidate to in the respective poll-books and ascertain the aggregate number of votes, and shall, at the Town Hall, or other place at which the remination was held, at noon of the day following the return of the pell-books, publicly declare the Reeves and Councillors, or Reeve, Deputy Reeve, and Councillors, as the case may be, who have been elected.
- Casting vote in case of a tie.

 11. In case two or more candidates have an equal number of votes, the said Township Clerk, whether otherwise qualified or not, shall give a casting vote for one or more of such candidates, so as to decide the election; and except in such case no Township Clerk shall vote at any such election.
- Nomination and election of Reeves and Canada there shall in like manner be a nomination of candidates for Reeves and also for a Deputy Reeve if such town be entitled to a Deputy Reeve; the election of such Reeve, or Reeve and Deputy Reeve, as the case may be, shall be conducted in the same manner in all respects 45 as is now by law provided for the election of Mayor in the same towns.
- Reeves, &c., 13. The Reeves and Deputy Reeves so elected in towns shall in adtobe members dition to their qualification as members of the County Council, also be

members of the Town Council in addition to the number of councillors of Town now authorized by law.
