Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that the "Star Life Assurance Society" of England, has established a Canada Branch Office in the City of Toronto.

I forward you herewith a Prospectus and copy of our Report for the last year, and request your influence, as a Wesleyan Minister, in introducing the Society.

Many of the Ministers and Members of the Wesleyan Methodist Society are doubtless connected with other Assurance Offices, but the Star has peculiar claims to their sympathy and support.
