CHAPTER 30.
An Act to incorporate the Anglican Synod of the Diocese of British Columbia.
[ 6 th $A_{1}$ mil. 1889.$]$

WOHEREAS a petition has been presented from the Bishop and the Synod of the Diocese of British Columbia, such Diocese consisting Preamble. of Vancouver islam and other islands adjacent, praying that the Synod should be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition :

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the alice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, enacts as follows:-

1. The Synod of the Diocese of British Columbia shall be, ant the same is hereby, made and constituted a body politic and corporate, under the name of "The Anglican Simon of the Diocese of British Columbia," hereinafter called the Corporation.
2. The said Corporation shall consist of the Bishop of the said Members of the Diocese and his successors, to be from time to time appointed in such namer as is or shall be provided by the sail Synod, or the Provincial Synod of the Ecclesiastical Province hereafter to be formed, and of such other persons as are or may become members thereof, according to the constitution of the said Diocesan Simon, as the same exists at the time of the passing of this Act (which constitution is set forth in Schedule A of this Act), or as the sail constitution may, from time to time, be altered by the said Provincial Synod, or by the sail Diocesan Synod, acting with the powers vested in it by the Provincial Synod aforesaid.
3. Such Corporation shall have perpetual succession and a common Powers of the seal, with power to change, alter, break, and renew the same when Sard. and so often as they shall think proper, and the said Corporation may, under the same name, contract and be contracted with, sue and be
sued, impleal and be inplearkel with, answer and defend in all Courts

May acquire, \&e., land and other preperty. and places whatsonser; and the said Corporation shall be able and capahle in law, rejpectively, to purchase, take, hold, give, receive, enjoy, possess, and retain all messunges, lands, tenements, and immovable property, money, gools, chattels, and moveable property which have heen or horeatter shall be paid, given, granted, appropriated, devised or bequeathed to it, or purchased ly it, in any manner or way whatsoever, to, for, or in favour of the eleemosynary, ecelesiastical, and elucational uses and purposes, within the Province of British Cohnubia, of the Church of England, including thereby the nses and purposes of any purish, mission, institution, school, or hospital, commected with the Chureh of England in British Columbia.

Power to sell, mortgage, and lase lands.

4. The Corporation shall, in nddition to the powers conferved upon it by the next preeeding section of this Act, and subject to the provisions thereof, have power to sell, convey, exchange, alienate, mortgage, lease or lemise any lands, tenements and hereditaments held by the said Corporation, whether simply ly way of investment for the nses and purposes set forth in the next preceling section of this Act or not: and the Coporation may also, from time to time, invest all or any of its funds and moneys, and all or any funds and personal property which may be vested in, or nequired by, the Corporation for
l'ower to make roall illowances.
cleemosynary, ecclesiastical, or educational purposes aforesaid, in and upon any mortgage security of lands, tenemerts, and hereditaments, and in other securities in any part or parts of British Columbia; and for the purposes of such investment may take, receive, and accept a mortgage or mortgagres, or any assigment or assigmments thereof, whether anch mortgage or assignment be made and executed direetly to it in its own corporate name, or to some ather corporation or horly politie and corporate, or to some company or person or persons in trust for it, and shall have and enjoy the same, and as large, full and ample powers and rights of sale and foreclosure, action and suit upon and for the purpose of enforcing the covenants, stipulations, conditions, and agreements, and all matters and things contained in such mortgages, or any of them, and in as ample a manner, as if it were a private person able and capable in law ; and furthermore may sell, grant, assign and transfer such mortgages, or any of them, to any person, company or boly capable of receiving any assignoment thereof, and may release and discharge such mortgages, or any of them, either wholly or partly.
5. The said Corporation shall, in the case of land held by it, be able to set apart a portion of sueb land for the purpose of making a roal, or to make a free grant of a portion not exceeding one acre in extent for the purpose of a school, hospital, or other necessary public olject. le and reecive, immov: which priaterl, or why iceal, and Columourposes terl with

7. The said ('orporation may excrese all its power by and thromerh the exerotive commattee as established by the ronstitution aforesaid, or such other hoarls or committees as the said Corporation may from time to time appoint by resolution for the mangement of all or any of the aftaiss or property of the said Coporation, hot in acemance only with the trusts relating to any property to which any special trost is attacheal: the said Syool may also apolint a treasurer or treasmers, and make such regnations for the management and alminHow powers of the Synom are to be ex. ercised. istration of its property as it shall see fit. The Corporation shall also have the right of appointing any othicer or other neerlful agent or agents for the management of its attairs, and shall have all other rights necessarily incirlent to a borly corporate.
8. The terms "the Church of England," or "the Chureh of England Interpretation. in British Colmmbia," in all deeds, instrmments and doemments that have heen heretofore, or that may hereafter he, executed, dealing with rend or persomal property within the Province of British Colmolia, shall mean, monss a different construction is gathered from the deeds, instruments or documents, that portion of the Churels of Englamel within the Province of British Colmmbia.
9. Any conveyance of real estate, or any interest therein, vested in the Corporation sinall be fermed to le duly executed for that purpose if the same has affixed thereto the seal of the Corporation, verified by the signatures of the Bishop for the time being of the Diocese of British Colmmha, or his commissary duly appointerl, and the seeretary of the aforesail executive committee; mal a discharge of a mortgage, if exceuted in the same way, shall be deemed to he properly and effectively executed.
10. In all Arts of the Legislature of this Provinee heretofore passed relating in any wry to the Church of England, or to any of the ecclesiastical or educational institutions in any way connoterl here-
hixecution by synod of deeds granting lands. with, and in all deeds, locmments, and other writings heretofore excented where reforence is made to thr Diocesan Synod of British Colmmbin, cither in lireet terns or by inplication, or to any officers or committees thereof, the same shall hereafter lee construed as if the Corporation herely incorporated, and the committees mud officers thereof, were the hody and the committee and officers referred to in
 mittere mull oflimes．

## SCHEDULE 1.

## Constitution of the Sinod．

## I．

The Syoul shall eomsist of the Bishop of the Dincen，the clergy inly biensen ly the Bishop，and of hay repmentatives $t$ ，be duly elveter as hereinafter provided．

## II．

The lay representatives shall he male commmieants of at least one yan＇s stanling，and of the age of twenty－one yans and upwarls． They shall pereent to the secretary of the Symod a certificate of their dectim，signed ly the Chaiman of the meeting at which they were appointed，accorting to the following form：
＂I hereby certify that at a mecting of the electors of Church（or Distriet）held on the day of ，the following persons，commoniants of the chureh，were doly elected as lay representatives in Symul，and that there are entered on the roll of anectors persmins entitled to vote at this elcetion．
＂Dated the
lay of
＂Chairman．＂
And that the Chaimam shall also forwand to the Cherical Secretary of the Synor，immeliately after the election，a cortificate of election in the same form．

The lay representatives shall le elected evory three sons at a mesting to be summoned liy the Minister in charge, or in ense the charels be vacant, of the Minister be nhent on mable or refuse to smumon surd merting, then he the Chmolswatens or either of them; and suld mecting shall he held in ench parish or mission in binter week, or within twenty-one days thereafter, marl the representatives shall contimue in othee until others are elected: Provided, nevertheless, that if no clection be held within the time nforesabl, then it shall be lawfol for tive fualified electors to call meh mecting at such tinu and place as they think proper.

## IV

In ense of a vanancy oecmring in the representation of any parish or mission, by leath, resignation, on refusal to act, and if any lay ropresentative, elected as aforesaid, shall derline to serve as surh, of shall at any time resign his office, signifying the same in writing tor the Jncmolent, or shall remove from the diocese, the said office shall in any suels ease become vaeant, and the Incmubent or other person or perwons, as in the previous article provided for, shall proceed to call a new election; moreover, should any lay representative secede from the Chureh, or whfully alstain from the Holy Communion for the sace of one whole year, or wilfully absent himself from public worship for a spare of six months, or should he he convicted of any erime, he shall thereupon forfeit his sail oftice, and the Incumbent or Minister of the parish or mission for which he was a lay representative shall in like manner proceel to call a new election, as in the previous artiele is provided for.

## V.

The Minister shall preside at every such meeting, hut if he be unable or refuse to preside, or if there le no Minister, the electors may appoint it Chairman and proced to the election.

## VI.

Pullif: notire of every sueh meeting, whether ordinary or special, shall le given on two Sundays immediately preceding such meeting, and by notiee affixed to the door of each chureh at least ten days before the day of sueh meeting, or by either of such modes, specifying the time and place of meeting.

## VII.

All male persons of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, being accustomed members of that chmeh within the listrict for which the election is held, shall he entitled to vote for lay representatives, pro-
vided that hefore any person shall be witheal to wote he shall make and subseribe the following declaration :
 Angliean Chureh, in British Cohmbin, und la-kneg to no other religions denomination; nul I ann an acenstomed menhers of the congrogation of (hurch."

## VIII.

Every parish or mission in future Aball lem antitlef to chact two representatives, but whon the mumber of mentors in a chareh or
 sentatives, and when the monker of electorn miall e:xereed fifty they shall be entitled to elect six representatisen; and the Chairman of the meeting at which they are elected shall antify ahe momber of electors on the electoral roll of such churth or distrise, and that the said chureh or district is entitled to elect two or meme mimementatives, as the case may be.

## IX.

The quormu for the transaction of any buminas in the Syod shall consint of not less than one-fouth of the whime rumate:r of qualified Clergymen of the Diocese and a like propention of lay representatives, whose election shall have heen ertified $u$, by the Shecretary of the Synod, hat any less mmber shall have power whe atjomen from day to day until a guorum em be obtained.

## X.

All guestions hefore the sail Syuod shall, in thes first instance, be determined by a vote of the majority of the wewheres of the Synorl present, hut the Bishop, or any two membern of the Synot, may, after such vote shall have been taken, require tho wote: to be retaken ly orters, in which case such vote shall lee retaksth by orders; and the concurrence of the Bishop and a majority of the Clergy, and of a majority of the Laity, shall lee essential to gise validity to any act or resolution upon which such vote shall have lman taken.

## XI.

The Synol shall meet once in every two soarw, of oftener if required on a summons from the Bishop of the Bismeses, arml at such time and place as the Synod shall direct.

## XII.

The Bishop may, or in case of his alsenters of of a vacancy in the See, the Dean, or in his absence on nom-cemplianee, the Senior Arehdencon, or in his alsence or non-complians: the Archdeacon next in
seniority, or if there be mo Arrhlmem, then the Bishop's Commissary at the time such varaney or absenes shall ceeme, or if there be no sud Commissary, then any three: Clergymen, Luing members of the Symol, shall, on written reguisition from thee clarical and five lay members of the Symol, call a precial meeting on any ocemsm, at such time or plare as he or they, in smmoming soleh meeting, shall dirvect; and six wreks' notice of the time ani plare of mecting shall loe issued to all persons entitlel to a suat thereat, by the Secretary of the Synod, or, in case of his nbsenee, or if the office be vacmat, by some person appointed for that pirpose by the persons summoning the Synowl.
XIII.

Notice of all meetings of the Symod shall be given ly the Seceretary of the Symol, in writing, to the persons entitled to a seat thereat. A notice, duly adressed and placed in the post oflice, shall be sulficient alvice.

## XIV.

When the Bishop is present he shall preside at all meetings of the Synoul, and when he is not present his Commissary specinlly authorized shall presile: and if the Bishop has mot appointerl a Commissary, then the Senior Dignitary or Clergyman of the Diocese present shall preside.

## XV.

A Secretary shall the chosen ly the Laity and one by the Clergy, on the first day of each ammal mecting of the Synod, and they shall remain in oflice during the pleasure of the Symol. It shall he their duty to keep regular minntes of all proceedings of the Synod, and record them in a book proviled for that purpose, to preserve all records and papers and othor documents, and faithfully to deliver into the hands of their suceessors all property, hooks, and papers relating to the concerns of the Synod which may be in their possession.

## XVI.

Any proposition for the alteration of this constitution, of of any other of the canons, shall he sent to the Execntive Committee, and by them laid before the Syool to be considered at the ensuing meeting, and, if approved lyy the Bishop and a mingority of the members of the Symod, shall lie over to the next mecting of the Syood, and if again approved by the Bishop, ant a majority consisting of two-thirds of each of the two orders of the Clergy and Laity, it shall be confirmed.
