The Missionary Committee to the Friends of Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada West.

MISSION, as Webster explains, "a person sent to propagate religion, or evangelise the heathen."

Now, it may be asked, what business have we in this case? We reply, our authority is not the civil government, but immediately derived from God, as laid down in the New Testament. "Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you, and lo I am with you alway, even to the end of the world." Now this appointment could not begin and end with the *first* Missionaries, as they could not Mission *all* the world; first, on account of a large part of the world being then unexplored; and secondly, for want of length of life, as most of the Apostles perished by early martyrdom. It follows, therefore, that the appointment applied to all *true* Missions to the "end of the Age."

But what evidence have we, as Primitive Methodists, that we have a *real* Mission? We submit, *first*, that the circumstances of our written history demonstrate its truth; *secondly*, it sprang not by planning and scheming in Committee Rooms, nor in schism, but in a revival of religion; *thirdly*, the Mission holds the true succession of Apostolic doctrine; and, *finally*, the palpable results it has realized.

But granting the Mission to be *real* and necessary in Britain, where it commenced, what proof is there that it is needed in *Canada*? On this we observe, that the *appointment* binds us to *all* the world; and as Canada is a part of the world, we are consequently required to work the Mission in Canada. It does not settle the question, to say there are other Protestant Missions in Canada, and that, in the opinion of some of their friends, they are sufficient to do *all* the duty. Our warrant obliges us to be *here*; and as thousands of the

population are evidently unsaved, and require missioning, we fully design to hold on in the enterprize, with other Missionary Churches, in preaching the gospel of the Lord Jesus throughout the length and breadth of this land.

This MISSION, a Branch of the Parent one in England, commenced in 1830, by a few emigrants, who established themselves in (*Little York*) Toronto, and has now distributed its Agents and operations over a considerable portion of this Western Province.

Without enumerating the force and Stations of the Primitive Methodist Churches in Britain, Australia, United States, or referring to the self-sustaining Stations (Circuits) in Canada, we have only embraced those Stations in this Province that require help from the Mission funds at the present period. Turn to the eighth page of this Report, where, in tabular form, those statistics are presented; and also to our financial position, is given in the balance sheet. To assist us with the large deficiency shown, the Parent Society makes a liberal grant, which still leaves a large balance to be made up *this year*, to prevent us from sinking into debt. About two-thirds of the English grant is received in cash, the rest in books, which are sent from our Book Room to the Stations, in part payment of their allowances. These books consist of Bibles with Hymn Books bound together, Hymn Books of all sizes, Monthly Magazines, books for Preachers' studies, &c., so that our Missionaries are also Bible, Tract, and Religious Book distributors, training the intellect and souls of the people in usefulness and happiness.

If our funds do not advance, (but we hope in God and your liberality they will,) we have no source at which we can borrow. There are only two courses for us to adopt. First, reducing the allowances of the Missionaries. Can this be done? All who know anything on this subject, will say it cannot. Secondly, give up some of the Stations, and send the men home!—disband the congregations and Sabbath Schools! Shall this alternative be quietly done? No. Neither of these alternatives must be consented to. And then, as a matter of experience, we know that to keep our present ground, we must Mission fresh, and push on the enterprise with unslackened energy. A noble array of friends have sustained the work in the past. They will still respond to the call of duty, and others will join our ranks, so that we will have more confidence in our trust. In addition to the yearly subscriptions of our people and the public, the children of our Sabbath Schools have been brought into the

hallowed service of raising supplies. This Report shows the names of those young disciples of the Lord Jesus who have, under the direction of their parents, ministers, and Sabbath School teachers, gone out with their Missionary cards, in greatly enlarging the total sum of the Missionary revenue. We trust this year the number of these collectors, and their success, will be greatly in advance of the past. It will be done if the young workers are encouraged. In this connection, we mention another pleasing branch of effort, which is the JUBILEE !

In October, 1860, the Jubilee year of our Church, a Jubilee Fund has been accumulating, and about \$1,820 have been raised. A Jubilee Mission, in Huron County, C.W., was commenced in July, 1861, sustained by this separate fund. On it there are two Missionaries, several preaching places, a new church erected, and about one hundred members.

During the past year, much material progress has been made in New Churches built, and lands secured for Parsonages and Churches, when the funds are available. Several revivals of religion have increased the number of church goers and the happiness of neighbourhoods, and many have departed this life praising God for the rich blessings conveyed to them through the Mission labours.

On these, and other grounds that might be mentioned, we confidently appeal to the public for sympathy and material aid, and especially to our own membership. Whilst we honor our Legislators in establishing good government,—the staffs of Professors of Colleges and Schools, in training our youth—the Bible and other Societies, in enlightening our population, we consider the services of the Missionary pre-eminent. How important the preaching of the gospel—the pastoral visiting of the tried and tempted—the consolations of religion offered to the dying in the cottage of the lonely settlement—these labours constitute a work that comports in simplicity and philanthropy the sublime mission of the world's Redeemer, who went about doing good.

"And now may the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that Great Shepherd of the Sheep through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."—Hebrews xiii. 20, 21.
