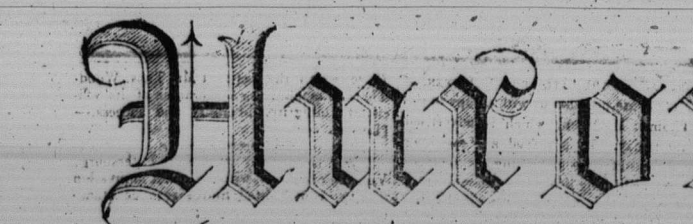

Lake Superior Boat Sunk. SEVENTY-FIVE LIVES LOST! Detroit, August 11, 10.30 a.m. Propeller Peawee, bound from Meteor, bound on Thunder Bay. Lake Huron. The Peawee sank in three minutes in deep water. Reports as to loss of life vary; probably not less than 75 lost. The Meteor is uninjured. Both boats belong to Whiting & Co.'s Lake Superior Line.

Arrival of the Cuba. THE ATLANTIC CABLE—INSULATION LOST—CAUSE UNKNOWN. Sandy Hook, Aug. 9.—The Royal Mail Steamship Cuba left here at 3.30 p.m. morning, bringing dates of the 22nd and 30th ult. Liverpool, July 30.—Via Queenstown. Seven hundred miles of the Atlantic cable paid out. One hundred and fifty yesterday, when insulation was lost; cause unknown. Further particulars had not transpired.
