

WATER-WORKS SALARIES

Important Meeting Yesterday of the Executive Committee.

There were present at yesterday's meeting of the Executive Committee, Chairman McMillan, Ald. Carthy, (St. Thomas), Gillespie, Galt, Morrison, Ivers, Acting City Treasurer Goady, Water-Works Superintendent Hamilton, and Secretary of Board of Works Rodden.
