CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

Unfavorable weather conditions are responsible for a decrease in the volume of the lumber trade during the past week. The demand continues steady, however, and country trade is picking up to some extent. Retailer who have been holding off in the hope of buying at lower figures are apparently being compelled by necessity to replenish their stocks. Low grade pine is in better demand than the upper grades, the price of which has reached a point which is regarded by many as prohibitive to their use. In Toronto trade is unsatisfactory owing to the light demand for building lumber. Dealers have deserted this market and are giving their attention to outside customers. Buying of stock by Michigan concerns is still in evidence. A Saginaw firm lately added 15,000,000 feet of pine to their holdings of Georgian Bay stock. Prices in most instances are well maintained, and the future does not seem to offer much encouragement to the prospective buyer who hopes to obtain any marked concession from present prices. While the midsummer quietness may develop, and with it a slight weakness in exceptional cases, the lumber list as a whole is not likely to weaken, while if there should be an active fall demand, a strengthening of values might result. Hardwood lumber is being bought heavily by manufacturing concerns.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Large shipments of lumber have been made from Montreal during the past week, the stock consisting chiefly of pine and spruce deals. The market is firm. It is understood that dealers have recently taken up options on considerable stock,

as there appears to be a feeling that a shortage in the supply may result. Spruce prices are showing a tendency to advance. Several manufacturers in Nova Scotia are shipping largely to the South American market. The cedar shingle situation seems to be a little uncertain. Some firms are offering extras freely at \$3.45, Boston delivery, while others are holding out for \$3.50. Clears range from \$2.90 to \$3.00.

MANITOWA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA.

A slight falling off in the demand for lumber is reported by the manufacturers who supply the western trade. This is due in part to the temporary cessation of building operations in Winnipeg as the result of a dispute between the contractors and the brick-makers. The building season in that city is further advanced than in any previous year. This has brought about a shortage in the brick supply. The contractors claim, however, that a recently-formed syndicate is manipulating the market for the purpose of shutting out certain contractors and legal proceedings have been resorted to with a view to enforcing deliveries. It is expected that an early settlement will be reached, when work will be proceeded with as usual. The demand for British Columbia lumber is steady. In addition to shipments eastward, the local consumption is quite large. A warehouse about to be commenced in Vancouver will call for 1,000,000 feet of lumber. The Brunette saw mills at New Westminster were compelled to shut down for a time on account of high water.

UNITED STATES.

With the immediate lumber demand in the United States there is very little complaint. Buyers have been more numerous of late in the Lake Superior district, and manufacturers have been unable to accumulate any supply of dry stock. Practically all the lumber now in the yards is sold. The settlement of the labor troubles in New York was short-lived, hostilities having again broke out and work being tied up more completely than ever. The loss of this market is felt quite keenly by dealers at Albany, Buffalo and Tonawanda, but when building in that city resumes its normal condition there should be a very active demand for lumber. High grade pine is exhibiting less firmness than the lower grades, for which there is a very active enquiry. Orders for bill stuff are so numerous that the mills are unable to meet the demand. There is also a pronounced scarcity of box lumber. Box concerns have sent representatives into the saw-milling districts in the hope of buying direct, but have not been very successful,

the mills having little stock for sale. Mill culls sell readily.

Hardwood lumber of all kinds is very strong. Maple appears to have taken the lead in place of basswood, although the latter is still in excellent demand. Dealers are buying liberally in advance of requirements, many of them having already contracted for their year's supply. The new cut is now coming on the market, but there are no indications of lower prices.

A renewed demand for 18 inch shingles is reported from Buffalo. Red cedar shingles are the weakest feature.

The future of the lumber market seems uncertain. It will depend largely upon crop conditions, which at the moment are favorable for wheat, but not as good as might be desired for corn. Should the crop harvested be equal to or above the average, it will go a long way towards sustaining the lumber market. Salesmen who have canvassed the eastern trade report that it has been difficult to book orders for delivery later than August.

GREAT BRITAIN.

Persons who have held the opinion that the lumber trade of Great Britain is likely to decline in the near future are pointing with some degree of satisfaction to the possibility of a general election as the result of the Hon. Mr. Chamberlain's new policy. They argue that the situation offers little encouragement to buyers and that prices are likely to weaken before the close of the year, even if such a result is not experienced immediately. There is a great diversity of opinion, and it will be necessary for the public to show greater confidence before any activity will be witnessed. Consumption is only moderate. Reports concerning Canadian lumber are of an encouraging character. The high prices recently quoted are being maintained. Large quantities of whitewood are being shipped from Southern Europe to London, much of it on consignment. This has resulted in a slightly easier market for Canadian spruce in stock, but c. i. f. prices have not been affected. Agents of shippers have refused to entertain lower offers, as they believe that the probability of a shortage in the supply justifies the prices at which stock is now being held. It is even stated that many contracts for future delivery have been declared void owing to the large number of logs that are hung up. Large quantities of stock from Quebec are going direct into consumption. The freight market is favorable to business, the rates quoted being exceptionally low.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The barque Fruen is loading deals at St. John, N. B., for the United Kingdom.

The steamer Fenchurch is loading deals at St. John, N. B., for the United Kingdom.

The steamer Norden is about to load deals at Riviere du Loup, Que., for Cork, Ireland.

The steamer Russ is loading a cargo of deals at Pugwash, N. S., for Great Britain.

The steamer Troid is loading a cargo of

deals and boards at St. Thomas, Que., for London.

Lath prices in Chicago are \$3.50 for No. 1 white pine, \$3 to \$3.15 for No. 1 mixed, and \$2.75 for No. 2.

M. L. Tucker, of Parrsboro, N. S., estimates that the deal shipments from West Bay this season will be 30,000,000 feet.

The schooner Onora arrived at Halifax, N. S., last week from Norfolk, with 70,000 feet of creosoted piling for the breakwater at Herring Cove.

The barque St. Croix is loading lumber at Annapolis, N. S., for South America, and the barque Grenada is loading at Bear River for a southern port.

There is a large demand throughout Michigan for cedar posts, ties, and telegraph and telephone poles, which is curtailing the supply of shingle timber.

The Hanbury Manufacturing Company, of Brandon, Man., last week received a drive of 5,000,000 feet of logs, which were floated down the Assiniboine river.

W. H. Murray, of St. John, N. B., has purchased from W. J. Scott, of Springfield, 1,000,000 feet of spruce logs which were cut along the i'fswick river last winter. It is understood that the price paid was in the vicinity of \$12 per thousand feet.

The New Brunswick Government will offer for sale at Fredericton, on July 2nd, three square miles of timber limits north of the New Canaan River, above mouth of North Forks, the applicant for which is H. B. Hetherington.

The S. P. Benjamin Company, of Wolfville, N. S., have so far this year loaded six vessels with lumber and expect to have between 6,000,000 and 7,000,000 feet more to ship. Their loading place for small vessels is Hantsport, but the large-sized vessels and steamers load further down the river.

H. Newsom, Sons & Company and Harry Smith & Company held an auction sale of lumber at Hull, England, on June 11th. Prices realized were as follows: 3rds Quebec spruce, 3 by 7, £7 5s; 3 by 8 £7 10s; 3 by 9, £8 10s; 3 by 10, £8 5s; 3 by 11, £8 15s to £9 5s; 2nds ditto, 3 by 7, £7 10s to £7 15s; 3 by 10, £8 15s; 2/3s ditto, 3 by 11, £8 15s; 12 to 13, £8 to £8 5s; 3 by 10 and 11, £9; 3 by 8, £7 10s; 3 by 7, £7 10s. Red pine A, 3 by 8, £8 15s; u/s Quebec red pine, 3 by 7, £9 to £9 5s; 4 by 9, £9 15s to £10. 3rds Quebec yellow pine, 3 by 11, £12. Quebec best pine sidings, 1 1/2 by 7 to 14, £17.

Under date of June 6th Messrs. S. P. Musson, Son & Company say of the Barbadoes lumber market: "The arrivals have been the "Francis A. Rice," from Church Point, with 134,000 feet of spruce; "E. Alexandra," from Kingsport, with 49,

000 feet white pine, 22,000 feet spruce and 26,000 feet hemlock; and the "Gold Seeker" on 3rd inst. with 173,000 feet white pine, 22,000 feet spruce and 13,000 feet of hemlock. The cargo of the first vessel was sold at \$18.50 for shipping and \$15.50 for second quality; the cargo of the Alexandra brought \$27.10 for shipping and \$21.10 for second quality white pine, \$16 for second quality spruce and \$17.50 for shipping, and \$15 for second quality hemlock. A cargo of white pine could, we think, be placed in the neighborhood of \$26 for shipping and \$21 for second quality. The only receipt of shingles was 100,000 Long Cedar of ordinary quality, which have been sold at \$3.33."

QUEBEC TIMBER LIMIT SALE.

As previously announced, a sale of timber limits was held in the Crown Lands Department, Quebec, on June 16th. Hon. S. N. Parent, Minister of Lands, Mines and Fisheries, presided, assisted by Mr. E. 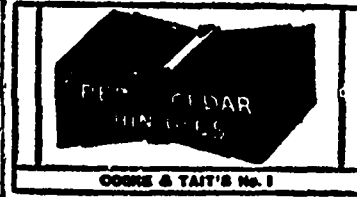
