REMARKS.

When gold coins have been clipped, or made light by any other process, the following will enable you to ascertain their value—the test is with American silver:

Half Eagle is equal in weight to.....31½ cents of silver.

Sovereign is equal in weight to.....30 cents of silver.

Napoleon is a shade lighter than.....25 cents of silver.

X Thaler is a shade lighter than.....50 cents of silver.

Ten Heller is equal in weight to.....25 cents of silver.

Doubloon is equal in weight to.....100 cents of silver.

* An American quarter and a fair Spanish alpenze.

Those Coins used in Commerce: such as Sovereigns, 20 Franc Pieces, X Thalers, Spanish and Patriot Doubloons and Dollars, &c., will course fluctuate, with the difference between demand and supply. Their quotation in this book can only correspond with their value in use, and what they are actually worth in passing from hand to hand.

It will be perceived that we have reduced the quotations to the gold coins of Central America. Pieces dated 1850, of reduced fineness and consequently of less value, have recently made their appearance. From the close resemblance of the Austrian Half Sovereign and Ducat, persons have mistaken the one for the other, and in order to prevent mistakes in future, we have placed them side by side on page 7.
