

Among other things which we ought to reform in this country is precisely that phase of public life. "The last Government has done some good things, undoubtedly. They did start a reform of the civil service which produced great good at Ottawa. It will remain for us to perfect what has breen left imperfect, to extend this reform to the outside service in order that we may have a civil service, both inside and outside, free from these trammels. I would not like you to understand that I approve of the meddling of anybody connected with the public service in politics. It is a rule in England that all public servants must refrain from any interference, active or partizan, with politics. The application of that rule is absolutely essential to an efficient public service."

When this reform is accomplished in its entirety it will stand as one of the wisest and most statesmanlike acts of any Government since Confederation,


