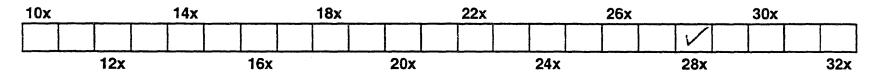

# BILL

### An Act to authorize Charles Lockey Beard to practise as a Provincial Land Surveyor,

WHEREAS, Charles Lockey Beard, of the City of Hamilton, in the P. eamble. County of Wentworth, in the Province of Canada, Civil Engineer, hath by his Petition to the Legislature represented that he has served from the seventh day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty

- 5 eight, to the seventh day of December one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, under articles to James Meadows Rendel, late of the City of London, in that part of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ire land called England, Esquire, a Civil Engineer and Surveyor, and late President of the Institution of Civil Engineers in that City, for the pur
- 10 pose of learning and practising that profession, and that during the whole of that period he was constantly employed by and under the said James Meadows Rendel, in surveys and other works connected with the practice of a Civil Engineer and Surveyor in England aforesaid; that he the said Charles Lockey Beard has also been engaged in Canada for some years
- 15 past in surveys and other works connected with the said profession of a Civil Engineer and Surveyor; and Whereas the said Charles Lockey Beard hath further represented that he has, both before and during the period of his employment and service under Articles, gone through a course of Geometry, and the various other branches of Knowledge speci-
- 20 fied in the Surveyor's Act for this Province, and is well versed therein, and also in the theory and practice of the said profession of a Civil Engineer and Surveyor, and has produced evidence thereof; and Whereas the said Charles Locky Beard hath prayed that an Act may be passed enabling him, upon giving the notice required by Law, and upon payment of
- 25 the proper fees, and giving the necessary security, and taking and subscribing the oaths required, to practise as a Land Surveyor, in and for that part of the Province of Canada which tormerly constituted Upper Canada, without being required to comply with any further or other requirements in the several Acts contained;
- 30 Therefore He M jesty, by and with the a lvice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

It shall be lawful for the Board of Examiners for Upper Canada, Board of Examiners for Upper Canada, Board of Examiners for Upper established under the Act passed in the Session held in the Twelfth Year Canada may ado of Her Majesty's Reign, Chapter 35, as amended by the Act passed in the profice as a two y yor, on certain 35 Session held in the Fourteenth and Fifteenth Years of Her Majesty's conditions.

Reign, Chapter 4, and also amended by the Act passed in the Session held in the Eighte nth Year of Her Majesty's R sign, Chapter 83, and they are hereby required, upon the application of the said Cha les Lockey Beard, at any meeting of the said Board, after the passing of this Act, and the said Charles Lockey Beard having first given due notice and paid 5 the proper fees required by the said Acts, to admit the said Charles Lockey Beard to practise as a Land Surveyor, in and for that part of the Province of Canada, which formerly constituted Upper Canada, without requiring him to comply with any further or other requirements or provisions in the said Acts contained, and to grant him a Certificate in the 10 form of Schedule A. to this Act; which Certificate shall have the same force and effect as if it were made according to the usual form, and shall, on the said Charles Lockey Leard entering into the Bond, and taking and subscribing the Oaths, in the Surveyor's Acts mentioned, enable him to practise as a Land Surveyor in and for that part of the Province of Ca- 15 nada aforesaid.

Public Act.

II. This Act shall be a public Act.

Form of Certificate of admission of Charles Lockey Beard, as a Provincial Land Surveyor. 20

This is to certify, to all whom it may concern, that Charles Lockey Beard, of the City of Hamilton, in the County of Wentworth, has appeared before the Board of Examiners, and has complied with all the requirements of an Act passed in the Session held in the year of Her Majesty's reign, entitled "An Act to authorize Charles Lockey Beard 25 to practise as a Provincial Land Surveyor."

Wherefore the said Charles Lockey Beard is admitted to the said office, and is by law authorized to practise as a Land Surveyor, in that part of the Province of Canada, which formerly constituted Upper Canada.
