## An Act to incorporate the "Stadacona Club" of Quebec.

**WHEREAS** an Association of persons hath existed since the month of Preamble.  
 March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-one, in the City  
 of Quebec, in Lower Canada, under the name of the "Stadacona Club";  
 And whereas the persons composing such Association have by their  
 5 petition prayed that the said Association may be incorporated, and it  
 is expedient to grant their prayer: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and  
 with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly  
 of Canada, enacts as follows :

 ciation, shall be and are hereby declared to be a body politic  
 and corporate, in deed and in name, by the name of the "Stadacona  
 Club," and by that name shall have perpetual succession and a common  
 30 seal, and shall have power from time to time to alter, renew, or change  
 such common seal at their pleasure; and shall by the same name from  
 time to time, and at all times hereafter be able and capable to purchase,  
 acquire, hold, possess, and enjoy, and to have, take, and receive to them  
 and their successors, to and for the actual occupation of the said Corpo-  
 35 ration, any lands, tenements, and hereditaments, and real and im-  
 moveable property and estate, situate, lying, and being within the said  
 City of Quebec, and the same to sell, alienate, and dispose of when-  
 soever the said Corporation may deem it proper so to do; and  
 by the same name shall and may be able and capable in law to sue  
 40 and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto,  
 in any manner whatsoever; and the Constitution, Rules, and Regula-  
 tions now in force touching the admission and expulsion of members, and  
 the management and conduct generally of the affairs and concerns of  
 the said Association, in so far as they may not be inconsistent with the  
 45 laws of this Province, shall be the Constitution, Rules, and Regulations

Proviso: as to alteration. of the said Corporation; Provided always, that the said Corporation may from time to time alter, repeal, and change such Constitution, Rules, and Regulations, in the manner provided by the Constitution, Rules, and Regulations of the said Corporation.

Transfer of property of the Association to the Corporation. II. All property and effects now owned by or held in trust for the said Association, are hereby vested in the said Corporation, and shall be applied solely to the maintenance of the said Corporation. 5

Liability of members. III. Members of the said Corporation shall be liable for the debts thereof, as if the Association was unincorporated, but they shall not be sued except after discussion first had of the property and effects of the said Corporation. 10

Public Act. IV. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
