

England's Irish Population.

From the London Echo.

In 1881 the Irish in England numbered, all In 1881 the Irish in England numbered, all told—we, of course, exclude men of Irish descent—962,374 or some 4000 less than in 1871, and their distribution over the country was most unequal. In purely agricultural counties their numbers were insignificant, while in the great manufacturing and mining counties they formed a not inconsiderable fraction of the population. Thus, in Lahenshire, they formed 6.1 per cent., in Cumberland 5.0 per cent., in Durham, 4.2 per cent., and in Cheshire 3.7 per cent of the population. In no one of the following counties was the percentage as high as 0.3: Cardigan, Radnor, Norfolk, Huntington, Merioheth, Suffolk, Canibridge, Buckingham, Carnarthen and Wilts. Passing from counties to towns, in Liverpool the Irish formed 12.8, in Eirken


