## Forest Fires！

The Attention of the Public is called to the following provisions of the FOREST FIRE ACT：
1．－Any person who sets out，makes or starts a FIRE for any purpose whatever，between the Fifteenth
Day of April and the First Day of December，in or near Day of April and the First Day of December，in or near
woods，or without selecting a place free from dry trees， woods，or without selecting a place free firbl in which to make or start such FIRE，or fails to remove all such make wood，brushwood or inflammable material within a distance of ten feet from such fire in every direction or fails to completely extinguish the same before leav－ ing．

2．－Throws or Drops any Burning Match，Ashes of a Pipe，Lighted Cigar or any other burning substance． 3．－Or fails to totally extinguish any camp fire be－ fore breaking camp，shall be liable to a Penalty of not less than $\$ 50$ nor more than $\$ 400$ ，or imprisonment for a period of twelve months．
