"Large as the figures seen," remarks the Doctor, " there is every reason to believe that they are even larger in proportion to pop-ulation in this fair Dominion of ours." The Doctor notes with thankfulness that hope is again dawning for this unfortunate class. There never was a time when the sub-ject of inebriety met with such profound at-tention. From thousands of homes and tens of thousands of voices in Canada there is a cry for help. The need of special medical care in special surroundings is being recognized in all directions. It is safe to predict, asserts Dr. Elliot, that not far away in the future ine-briety will be regarded as smallpox cases are, not with loathing so much as with sympathy and piky, the metriate will be placed in quar-antine and treated for his malady till he re-covers.
