Foreword

The Royal British Colonial Society of Artists was founded in 1886 for the purpose of holding Exhibitions in the Colonies. In 1904 the scope of the Society was enlarged to include all the British possessions and dependencies and the present title received Royal sanction.

Alfred William Strutt was born in Taranaki, New Zealand. Received his art education under his father William Strutt, and at South Kensington, London, where he was awarded medals. He has exhibited much at the Royal Academy and is represented by work at the municipal art galleries of Wolverhampton, Burnley and Blackpool.

2. WINTER MORNING IN THE HIGHLANDS....£220 A.K.Brown, R.S.A., R.B.C., R.I., R.S.W.

Alexander Kelloek Brown is a well-known Seottish landscape painter. Studied art at Glasgow School of Art with the intention of becoming a designer but abandoned it for landscape painting. He exhibits much at the Royal Academy, the Royal Scottish Academy, in Paris and Munich.

St. George Hare was born in Limerick. Studied at South Kensington. Hon. A.R.C.A.

4. THE JAFFA GATE, JERUSALEM......£138 Percy R.Craft, R.B.C.

Percy R. Craft. Born in London. Received art education at South Kensington, Heatherley's, and Slade School, under Sir E. J. Poynter and Professor Legros. Was elected a member of the Royal Society of British Artists, but later resigned. Resided for many years in the Newlyn Art Colony. A frequent exhibitor at the Royal Academy of Arts, the Salon Paris, the New Gallery, and the principal provincial exhibitions. Has a work acquired by the Grahamstown Art Gallery. Is a gold and silver medallist.

5. WHERE THE BREAKERS ROAR......£57.15 W. Follen Bishop, R.B.A., R.B.C., R.C.A.

Walter Follen Bishop, a painter of English landscape and rural country life. Art education at Liverpool and Paris at the Atelier Julian under Professors W. A. Bouguereau and Tony Robert Fleury. Works of his have been acquired for the Welsh Museum of Arts, Cardiff, the municipal permanent collection, Liverpool, Pietermaritzburg, South Africa, and the South Australian National Gallery.

6. MOONLIGHT, CORNISH COAST £66 Julius Ollson, R.A., P.R.O.I., R.B.C.

Julius Ollson. Born in London. His art education was self acquired and he was for many years a well-known member of the artist colony of St. Ives in Cornwall. Many of his works have been acquired for public galleries including Winnipeg Gallery permanent collection. Is a gold medallist and *hors concours* Paris Salon.

Fred Milner, A.R.B.C.

Fred Milner. Born in Yorkshire. Studied at the Slade School. Is represented by important works in the Corporation Art Gallery, Preston, and National Museum, Buenos Ayres. Was elected a member of the Royal Society of British Artists, but afterwards resigned.

Edgar Bundy, A.R.A., R.I., R.B.C.

Edgar Bundy's art education is entirely self-acquired and he commenced painting at the age of 14. Was elected a member of the Royal Society of British Artists, but afterwards retired. He has had a work purchased for the nation under the Chantrey bequest. He has been awarded medals at the Paris Salon and many other exhibitions.

Stanhope Alexander Forbes. Born at Dublin. Art education at the Lambeth School of Arts, the Royal Academy Schools, and at the Atelier Bonnat, Paris. Is generally recognized as the pioneer of the "Plein Air" school of painting in England, of which his picture, "A Fish Sale on a Cornish Beach" was probably the first. A well-known member of the artists' eolony of Newlyn in Cornwall. Is represented by works in most of the provincial public galleries, and a picture of his was purchased under the Chantrey bequest. Is a corresponding member of the Institute de France.

Was elected a member of the Royal Society of British Artists in 1894, and resigned in 1914 Was fine art commissioner and organizer of the British Fine Art Section of the Japan-British Exhibition, 1910, and the Coronation Exhibition, 1911. Was awarded a medal at the Barcelona International Art Exhibition and is a frequent exhibitor at the Royal Academy of Arts, the Salon, Paris, the Royal Glasgow Institute, Royal Institute of Painters in Water Colors, and other prominent exhibitions.

Was awarded a medal of the first class at Munich in 1896, and medals at Munich, Dresden, and Barcelona. Great grand medal at Buda-Pesth. Has well-known works in the Pinakothek, Munich, the National Galleries of Brussels, Ottawa, Canada: and Santiago de Chile, Musee de Leige, Art Museum Toronto, National Gallery, Wellington, New Zealand, and Publie Galleries of Aberdeen and Bath.






