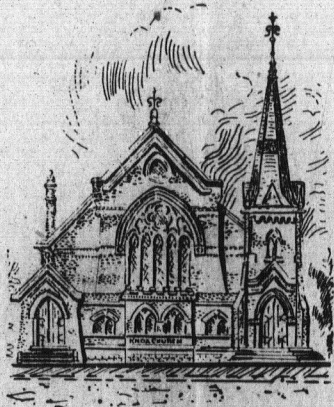

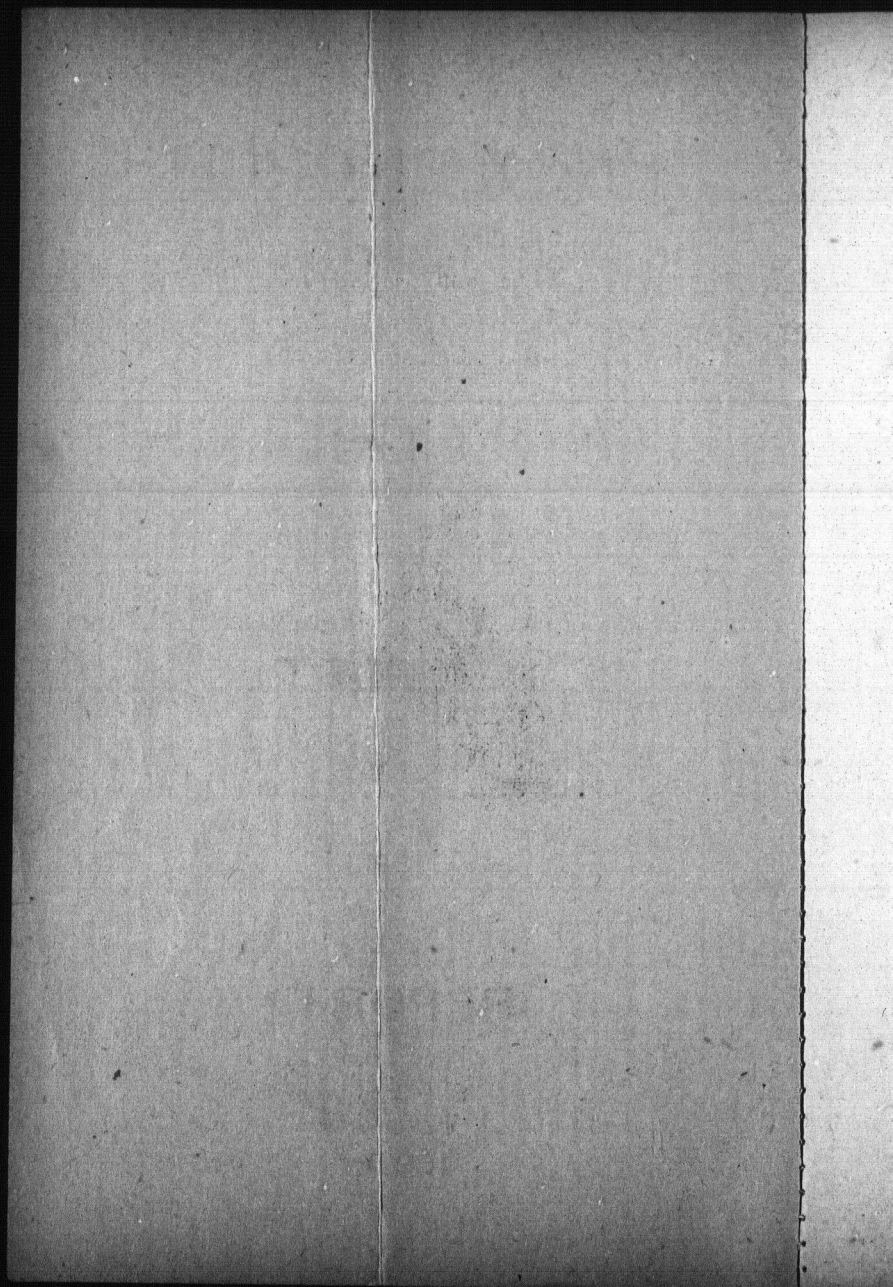

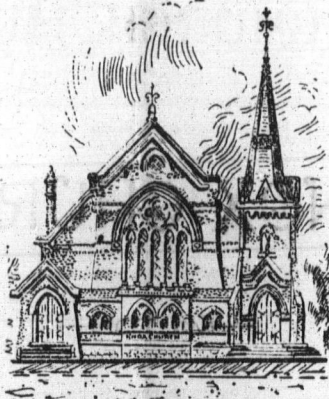

Annual Meeting

The Annual Meeting of the members and adherents was held in the church on the evening of 20th January. The meeting was interesting and the Building Committee gave a full and satisfactory account of the progress of the new church and of the success they had met in collection of funds for carrying on the work, and were authorized not only to look after the completion of the church, but also see to the furnishing, heating, lighting, seating, carpeting and all other necessary arrangements, using their own discretion in carrying out the completion of the same. The Managers' Report shewed that they had been able to meet all expenses, and also explained the envelope system which was being introduced, by which they hope to increase the funds, if necessary, to meet the expenses in the payment of interest and other incidental outlay for the ensuing year and collection of the moneys for the schemes of the church.
