FIRES.

The saw mill and stave factory of J. E-Murphy at Hepworth, Ont., were destroyed by fire last week. The loss is about \$3,000, partially covered by insurance.

The factory of the Columbia Handle & Tool Company, London, Ont., was completely destroyed by fire on 9th inst. The loss on plant and stock is about \$20,000.

Mr. V. Travers, of Liverpool, England, is about to visit Canada and the United States in connection with contracts for the importation of timber. The trip is being undertaken in the interest of his firm and that of Messrs. Sieveking, Podmore & Company, 7 Crosby Square, London.

CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

Another circumstance has transpired to further strengthen the position of white pine lumber. The recent mild weather has seriously interfered with logging operations, and in many districts prevented entirely the hauling of logs to the streams. Should the weather continue mild, a large quantity of logs will necessarily be left in the woods. An operator in the Georgian Bay district states that fully one third of the winter's cut of logs on the north shore remains to be hauled, and that the present outlook is anything but encouraging. As a large proportion of the white pine production of the coming season has already been contracted for, a considerable reduction in the cut of the mills would be likely to bring about a-famine in this class of lumber. The market at the present time, therefore, is exceptionally strong. Ottawa valley manufacturers speak most hopefully of the prospective demand. The heavy buying in that district of late by United States concerns has almost wiped out the supply of good lumber, while the stock of the lower grades has been reduced to a point which gives the seller the advantage in effecting sales. The building season is opening up satis factorily, although in Toronto talk of labor troubles has produced a somewhat unsettled feeling and may restrict the volume of building until the matter is finally settled. 'The open weather has created a brisk enquiry for shingles. Hemlock lumber is stronger, sales in Toronto ranging from \$12.50 to \$13 Implement and furniture factories are buying hardwoods liberally, and although prices have not materially improved, it is believed that the foundation is being laid for a substantial advance later on.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The probability of early spring sawing has caused a slight weakening of the spruce lumber market in respect to local trade. There has been an average input of logs, and if weather conditions this spring should be favorable for lumbermen, the mills are likely to make a large cut. Some manufacturers will this year saw a smaller quantity of British deals than usual and give more attention to the United States and home markets. Prices of clapboards continue high, sales of extra spruce having been made for Boston delivery at \$36. Extra ced ir shingles are selling at \$3.30, while some manufacturers are holding out for a ten-cent advance on this figure. Spruce laths have improved, the average quotation for 158 inch, on Boston freight rate, being \$3.10.

UNITED STATES.

Adverse weather conditions have affected the lumber conditions of the past ten days. In the Eastern States torms and high water have limited the volume of business, and in almost every section some trouble from this cause is reported In the logging districts the weather has been so mild that it has been necessary to cease hading in some instances, and as the result a shortage in the log crop may be encountered. This condition has further strengthened the white pine mar ket. Eastern dealers report that they have sufficient orders on hand to keep them busy for another month. A seneral advance in the price of low grade pine seems to be due, and it is the wonder of the trade that it has not taken place. Hardwood prices are showing a tendency to advance. Considering the light stock of most krades, prices are not as high proportispately as white pine. Numerous inquiries are reported for maple and ash. Lath are scarce and high in price. Dealers are paking up shinkles wherever they can, and although the sawing season may open earlier than usual, the supply is not likely to be more than equal to the demand. Best 18-inch hemlock shingles are quoted in New York at \$3.15 to \$3.20, and clear pine at \$3.75. Hemlock boards and piece stuff are selling in the Saginaw valley at \$11 and \$12.50. At North Tonawanda the base price for hemlock is \$13.50 to

GREAT BRITAIN.

The position of the British market has not materially changed. Operations in Baltic and Swedish goods have been characterized by indifference, while the buying of Canadian lumber has been of a more careful character than usual. The standard sizes of deals are meeting with a ready sale, but there is much difficulty in disposing of inferior qualities. A report from Manchester states that spruce deals are effering c.i.f. for the coming season at about 15 shillings a standard under the highest figures touched in 1901, but even at these prices buyers are not eager to close contracts. This statement no doubt refers to New Brunswick and Nova Scotia spruce, as it is understood that a considerable quantity of Quebec sprace has been placed through the usual channels. The present stocks in Manchester and Liverpool contain a large quantity of 7 and 8 inch deals, 9 x 3 and 11 x 3 being very scarce. The claim is made that in recent years shippers have reduced the quantity of wide sizes in their specifications, and while the usual cut of deals formerly contained 25 per cent. 11 x 3 and 40 per cent. 9 by 3, now to and 15 per cent, respectively are all that is included, the practice being to take out the wide deals and sell them at It is contended that enhanced prices. this practice is not satisfactory to the British importer. The demand for timber is steady; waney pine and rock elm are scarce and strong, while square pine and soft elm are inactive and weaker-There is a large stock of ash at several ports, as owing to the high price substitutes are being used to some ex ent.

STOCKS AND PRICES

The city of Kingston, Ont., is asking for tenders up to the 13th inst. for the supply of 200,000 feet B. M. of pine plank, 3, 2 and 1½ inch, and 40,000 lineal feet of cedar sleepers, 5 x 4 inch.

Thomas Pitts & Company, of Bay City, sold on March 1st to Cleveland parties 8,000,000 feet of lumber to be manufactured at Cutler, Ont., this season. The price is not given, but is understood to he about \$16.50. be about \$16.50.

The wharf to be built by the Dominion Government at Caraquet, N. B., will require 306,000 feet of spruce timber, 98,000 feet hemlock timber, 142,000 feet birch timber, to be sawed, 1,370,000 feet hemlock logs, and 63,000 lineal feet ballast poles, of spruce, 7 inches at top. The contractors for this work are Simons & Burpee, of Gibson, N. B.

Sims Bros., of Little Current, Ont. Sims Bros., of Little Current, Ont.. confirm the report that they have sold this season's cut of logs to the Edward Hines Lumber Company, of Chicago, They advise us that they have also just sold last year's cut of white pine to Potter, Teare & Company and the Saginaw Bay Company, of Cleveland. Good prices were realized in each case, the sales aggregating about \$100,000.

Concerning the Barbadoes lumber market Messrs, S. P. Musson, Son & Company, in their report of February 15th say: "Arrivals have again been free during the fortnight, and the market continues in an overstocked condition. The "Rachael H. Boyd" has arrived with a cargo of 30,000 feet spruce and 76,000 feet white pine. The former was placed at \$17.25 for shipping and \$12.25 for second

quality, and \$11.50 for inferior. The "Foster Rice" arrived on 6th inst. from Annapolis, N.S., with 220,000 feet white pine, which had been sold to the contractor to H. M. Forces, for delivery at Antigua. The "Congo" arrived on the 7th from Weymouth, N.S., with 130,000 shipping white pine and 53,000 feet second quality, and on the 12th the "Damietta & Joanna" arrived from Calais to our address with 57,000 feet white pine "Damietta & Joanna" arrived from Calaisto our address with 57,000 feet white pine boards, 37,000 feet white pine plank, and 12,000 feet spruce scantling, which we placed at \$20.10 for shipping and \$15.10 for second quality boards, \$16.00 for shipping and \$11.00 for second quality plank, and \$12.00 for second quality plank, and \$12.00 for second quality spruce scantling. This steamer brought 2,000,000 cedar laying shingles, of which 1,000,000 was placed on contract at \$2.00; the remainder, owing to dealers being filled up, brought only \$1.70.

THE GLASGOW MARKET.

There has been more activity in the There has been more activity in the timber trade this month than last, and a fair amount of business has been done at firm prices. Severa shipments of Quebec and Lower Port spruce and red pine are rived during February, and in all cases as ale was effected from the ship,' side at satisfactory prices. The amount of business done here in contracting forward for Quebec timber and deals has been of only moderate dimensions, due no doubt to the moderate dimensions, due no doubt to the high prices quoted by the shippers. White pine, both in logs and deals, continues pine, both in logs and deals, continues very dear, and seems likely to continue so from all appearances. Deliveries from stock have been reasonably well maintained during the month, and of pine goods particularly the amount on hand must now be very small.

The Clyde shipbuilding returns show that the results appears to the contract of the contract

The Clyde shipbuilding returns show that 16 vessels, aggregating about 41,000 tons, were launched, compared with 15 vessels of 5,000 tons at the same period last yer. Unfortunately the amount of new besiness being placed is by no means considerable, which is not surprising in face of the low freights ruling. The house-building trade is showing a considerable revival fortunately, and new work amounting to about half a million sterling has been fixed during the past two months. two months.

WHITE PINE -Businessduring the month has been quiet. We hear of no transactions in waney boardwood, but there have been a few sales of first-class squ re deckwood, prices ranging from 2s. 6d, to 2s. 9d. per cubic foot, according to size. The stock of first quality waney pine is practically exhausted in first hands. There is, however, more than sufficient of square is, however, more than sufficient of square wood for prospective wants.

QURBEC BIRCH—The amount of business done during the month has been only trifling, and prices are unchanged at about 16d. for 14 inch average. The stock on hand is small, and there is very little in-

N. S. BIRCH-The stock on hand moves off very slowly, and prices show no improvement at a penny over the inch.

QUEBEC PLANES—The stock of Quebec planks have been cleared out, but there is still a large amount of Lower Port planks on hand. A shipment of about 100 standards Halifax planks arrived this month, and was dispused of at 65 to. and was disposed of at £6 105, per standard "ex quay" terms.

Asu-The market continues to be quite unusually dull, and there is not now the demand that used to exist in this market. demand that used to exist in this market. When the price was raised so much a year or two ago, the principal consumers of Quebec ash looked out for a cheaper substitute and found it in poplar, and now a number of them prefer the latter. The stock on hand is large, and is ample for requirements for some time to come.

THE BOSTON MARKET.

Again a snow-storm has made a quiet trket on spruce lumber. But if orders Again a snow-storm has made a quiet market on spruce lumber. But if orders are wanted—anything that has to be sawn—full prices have to be paid. Small randoms on the market, in cargoes that must be sold, hardly bring full prices, but even such lumber promises to do better as soon as house-building starts. Quotations are steady: Ten and 12 inch dimensions, \$20; 9 inch and under, \$18; 10 and 12 inch raudom lengths, to feet and up. \$10,50; 50; 2x3. lengths, to feet and up, \$19 to \$19.50; 2x3, 2x4, 2x5, 2x6, 2x7 and 3x4, to feet and
