There was no demand from shippers, as they had ample stock on hand, and trade in this line was dull. Cattle and hogs, with the exception of a few, were sold at 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 cents per lb. live weight. Owing to the continued unfavorable market, only one or two hogs were sold, and the fact that recent sales reported netted the shippers a loss of \$1.25 per head, there was a weaker feeling in this market to-day and prices declined 1/2 cent per lb. and even at this reduction exporters did not operate freely. Sales of good to choice stock were made at 3 1/2 to 4 1/2 cents per lb. live weight. The supply of calves was small and prices ranged from \$1 to \$3 each, and young pigs sold at 10 to 12 cents each.

The offerings of live stock at the Point St. Charles market were as follows: 100 sheep and 50 hogs. The demand for cattle was slow, but for hogs it was very active, changing hands at 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 cents per lb. and at 4 1/2 cents per lb. The sheep offered were of good quality, and were bought on export accounts at 3 1/2 to 4 1/2 cents per lb. Hogs met with a ready sale at 4 1/2 cents per lb. and at 5 1/2 cents for light-weights per lb.

IT CONDEMNS RHODES.

South Africa Commission's Report on the Transvaal Raid.

A VERY HEAVY RESPONSIBILITY REMAINS

The Commissioners Say, With the Ex-Premier of Cape Colony.

It is Found "That He Seriously Embarrassed Both the Imperial and Colonial Governments; That His Proceedings Resulted in an Astounding Breach of International Comity"—He Assisted a Revolution and Deceived the High Commissioners—Beit and Maguire Also Blamed—Mr. Labouchere Would Go Further and Condemn Hammond and Others—Mr. Chamberlain Not Blameless, in "Labby's" Idea—The Powers and Turkey—Cable News Generally.

London, July 13.—The Parliamentary South Africa Commission, which has been inquiring into the Transvaal raid has carried upon its report.

The Mail Magazine publishes a summary of the conclusions of the committee.

The report will express an emphatic opinion that whatever justification there might have been for action on the part of the people of Johannesburg, there was none whatever for Cecil Rhodes' conduct in subsidizing, organizing and stimulating an armed insurrection against the Government of the Transvaal. A heavy responsibility, according to the report, remains with Rhodes, despite the fact that at the last moment Dr. Jameson invaded the Transvaal without Rhodes' direct sanction. The gravity of Rhodes' transaction is weightily expressed by the committee, who find "that he seriously embarrassed both the Imperial and Colonial Governments; that his proceedings resulted in an astounding breach of international comity which he utilized his position and the great interests he controlled in order to assist and support revolution, and deceived the High Commissioner, as well as concealed his views from the members of the Colonial Ministry and the directors of the Chartered Company."

Beit Must Share Responsibility.

The committee is of the opinion that of the directors of the Chartered Company, who were examined, only Mr. Beit and Mr. Maguire were cognizant of the plans of Rhodes. A SERIOUS CONFLICT

Between British Troops and Bashi Bazouks.

SIXTEEN BRITONS KILLED.

And a Number of the Bashi Bazouks Also Bit the Dust.

The British Troops Intervened at Candia, Crete, to Protect Christians from the Turkish Rascals and the Fight Followed—The Foreign Fleets Have Sent Five Warships to Candia to Suppress Any Further Mohammedan Movement, and the Bashi Bazouks Are Ordered to Surrender Their Arms Within Four Days.

London, July 14.—The Times' Athens correspondent says official despatches have been received announcing that a serious conflict has taken place at Candia between a force of British troops and a party of Bashi Bazouks, arising from the British intervening in a skirmish between the Bashi Bazouks and Christians. Sixteen of the British force and a number of the Bashi Bazouks were killed. The admirals of the foreign fleets have sent five warships to Candia to suppress any further Mohammedan movement.

Further details of the conflict have been received, but passengers who have just arrived from Candia state that on account of excesses by Bashi Bazouks 300 British marines have been landed at Candia to replace the Italian expedition stationed there. The Bashi Bazouks have been summoned by proclamation to surrender their arms within four days. They have held a meeting and addressed a petition to the Sultan.

THE ATK-OKAN IRON RANGE Was Visited by The World's Mining Man.

TREMENDOUS DEPOSITS Which Will Mean Great Wealth When the District is Opened Up.

Ontario and Rany River Railway, to be begun this fall, will directly tap the Atk-Okan district - The location, owned by the Willey Brothers, has been thoroughly tested to show the magnitude of the ore deposits.

Port Arthur, Ont., July 9.-(Special Correspondence.)-Gold is not the only form of mineral wealth sought by Northwestern Ontario, for among other resources this part of the province has large deposits of iron.

But as to the Atk-Okan wilderness, which is the district under discussion in this letter, besides being wholly devoid of human inhabitants, it has been devastated by destructive forest fires.

To begin at the beginning, between 5 and 6 o'clock a.m. we struck camp on the south arm of Steep Rock Lake, and in the grey of the early morning proceeded through the forest to the westward.

Disembarking at a portage several chains long, we climbed a portage several chains long, or rather high, and very poorly cut by the Government, to a little lake, situated on the top of a mountain.

A Great Iron Range. A few miles up stream we came upon the famous Atk-Okan magnetic iron range, which some people say will yet be worth more than all of those gold mines of the country put together.

Regarding the geological occurrence of this iron belt, I have the authority of Mr. W. Russell of Port Arthur that the outcrops or surface showings appear as beds in Huronian, homblende and chlorite schists, which are nearly vertical.

The magnetic iron range consists practically of a mountain from 100 to 200 yards wide, between 100 and 200 feet high, and upwards of 20 miles in length.

High Grade Ores. The magnetic iron range consists of a remarkably high grade, a series of assays of rock taken from different points showing the existence of from 62 to 70 per cent. of iron.
