THE MISSIONARY COMMITTEE

TO THE FRIENDS OF PRIMITIVE METHODIST MISSIONS

DEAR CHRISTIAN FRIENDS,

The revolution of another year devolves upon us, the pleasing duty of laying before you, a brief account of our official services and the recent history, present state, and prospects of our Mission-stations.

We would first record our profound Gratitude to Almighty God, for His Smile and blessing upon our Missionary effort, crowning the Labors of our Servants, with great success,—and influencing our Friends to contribute liberally; during the last year, the amount being much larger than any former year.

We feel encouraged in now appealing to you for your continued and increasing support, from the fact that, our openings for Missionary Extension are numerous, and we have during the year received considerable reinforcements to our Mission Staff—both from our English Conference and Canadian volunteers.

It is with feelings of deep sorrow that we refer to the Sudden Deaths of our respected Bretheren in the Ministry, Mathew Nichols and James Steveson. Both we had hoped would have been spared, for many years of usefulness, in the Lord's vineyard.

But God ways are above our comprehension, but are all ordered by wisdom and love. Our Loss is their eternal gain, and while we mourn for them as christians, let their demise admonish us of the importance of immediate and constant activity in the cause of God, "let us work while it is day, for the night cometh when no man can work."

STATE OF THE MISSIONS.

WE rejoice to be able to state that all our Mission-stations have been prosperous during the year. Hamilton became a Selfsustaining Station last January. Walpole and Grand River Mission was made a Circuit last Conference with the privilege recorded in minute 6—see Conference Minutes.

Galt was separated from Blenheim at the said Conference, Blenheim being made a Circuit with the privilege mentioned above, Galt and Guelph was united, and Woodstock and Paris were made distinct and separate Missions, and all the other Mission-stations have increased in members and finances. A New Mission has been opened in the Town of London with a prospect of success.

REACH AND SCOTT MISSION.

This Mission has during the past year increased in members, and finances, and though not very prosperous; yet our prospects are good, and Brother Lyle, the Superintendent of this Mission informs us that he expects the Mission will be self sustaining by next Conference.

GUELPH AND GALT.

These Stations have not made much progress in the past year, but the Committee hope that by their union and by having stationed two very efficient Missionaries, Bros. Davison and Dudley, that they will have encouraging success to announce in their next report.

ORANGEVILLE.

This is an extensive and interesting Mission, embracing a large tract of comparatively newly settled country, and is properly a Mission-field, the Mission is prosperous and the prospects good.

KINGSTON MISSION.

This Mission has been very prosperous, having an increase last year of 90 members, and several excellent openings, the prospects were so encouraging that the Conference stationed two additional Preachers to open the Portland Mission in connexion with Kingston; we learn that the prospects of success are very encouraging—and we trust that though the Friends on that Mission must have felt severely on account of the

sudden death of Brother Nichol, their loss will to a great extent be made up by the appointment of Brother Thomas Crompton, who providentially arrived from England to fill his place.

PEEL AND WELSLEY MISSION.

This Mission had an increase, during the year, of 43 members, and our prospects for extending the work good, and considering that the Mission-field here is chiefly in new settlements, its financial condition is as good as could be expected.

WOODSTOCK MISSION.

This Mission was separated from Galt and Blenheim last Conference, and made a separate Mission. Brother Parsons reports the prospects good, several fresh places have been taken up and we trust it will do well.

LONDON MISSION.

This Mission was taken up last Conference, and William Stevenson, lately from England, stationed there, the prospects are good, and especially taken in connexion with the extensive Western country, for which London will become a center to extend our Missionary operations extensively in that direction.

PARIS AND BRANTFORD.

Paris was part of Galt and Blenheim Mission, was separated last Conference, and Brother Thomas Lawson stationed there. The reports are encouraging, and we trust under his efficient management it will speedily become a prosperous Mission.

We now proceed to lay before you a statement of the various Contributions to the Mission Fund from the Circuits and Missions, and also the Mission Treasurers' General Statement of Receipts, and Expenditure from which it will be evident that our Mission Fund is in a very satisfactory state, having a considerable Balance on hand at the close of the Conference year, but we would remind our friends that with the new Missions opened, and the additional Missionaries employed, our expenditure is considerably increased, and that already our balance is nearly all expended. We would therefore confidently appeal to their liberality for a continuance and an increase of their contributions, and we earnestly request their prayers to the God of Missions, for a gracious outpouring of his Spirit that the labors of his devoted servants may be crowned with abundant success.
