Sporting Sketches from New-Brunswick. BY M. H. PERLEY, ESQUIRE.

No. 2.—The Forest Fairies of the Millicets.

The bright rays of the morning sun, darting across the lake, and showing directly into "The Camp of the Owls," awoke us from our dreamy repose.

Breakfast over, the camp was broken up; our various equipments were placed in the canoes, and paddling down the lake, we passed through a short rapid stream, and then opened a large and beautiful sheet of water, as yet untrampled and unbroken.

The afternoon was spent in fishing the rapids; and rarely have I seen better sport. Few of the trout were less than a pound weight, very many of them weighed upwards of two pounds, while the largest did not exceed three pounds and a half.

Being fond of us again by the margin of the lake, listening to the rustle of the stream, and watching the last rays of the setting sun, gilding the tops of the hills, and the blue of the sky, we were in a happy mood.

After a time, and with great but cautious pressing, I drew from them, by degrees, a tradition, which being the Millicet tribe, seldom mentioned, except by their own camp fires, and in the presence of their own people.

Several very interesting and beautiful legends, which were related to us, when the weary and unsuccessful hunter had been invited to their lodges, partaken of their hospitality, and been allowed to join in their sports and dances.

The wistfulness of their dark eyes, sunny smiles, light lips, and graceful air movements, as they threaded their way through the forest, were so interesting, that we were unable to resist the temptation of following them.

The following day, at the earliest request of our Indians, we broke up our camp, and removed to another part of the lake, several miles distant, to avoid disturbing the good Indians, who in some vicinity had us unwittingly placed ourselves.
