MEETINGS.

The Committee have the honor to submit the following report of the Society's proceedings during the year, being the sixty-fourth since its foundation:—

The Anniversary of St. George's Day, 23rd of April last, was, as usual, celebrated by Divine Service in the Cathedral. The sermon was kindly preached by the Right Rev. A. Hunter Dunn, the Lord Bishop and Patron of the Society, to whom we desire to hereby convey the thanks of the Society.

Mr. E. A. Bishop, ably assisted by the Church Choir and other ladies and gentlemen, contributed the beautiful musical portion of the Service. The attendance was very large, which proves how popular this means of celebrating the Anniversary Day of our Patron Saint is.

The Society thanks all those who so kindly contributed to the success of the Service.

Christmas Cheer was provided as in the past to thirtyeight poor families of this city.

The Sub-Committee of Charity shows by its report that 288 cases were relieved during the year at the cost of \$460.65.

The Right Rev. George Jehosaphat Mountain, D.D., D.C.C., Lord Bishop of Quebec, was the second sou of Bishop Jacob Mountain, the first Anglican Bishop of Quebec. He was born 27th July, 1789, at Norwich, England; came to Canada of Quebec. He was born 27th July, 1789, at Norwich, England; came to Canada with his father, 1793, and died after a brief illuess at Bardfeld, his country seat, on the 5th January, 1863. He was nineteen years Rector of Quebec, and was consecrated Bishop of Montreal 14th Febuary, 1836, and of Quebec in 1850. He was a diligent visitor among his flock, and in the dreadful visitations of cholers in 1832 and 1834he literally lived night and day among the dying and the dead, while in 1847, when the province was visited with the plague of typhus fever, and the consumers to war driver by the search of the Discouring Statics. the poor immigrants were dying by thousands, at the Quarantine Station, the Bishop took his turn at Grosse Isle regularly with the rest of the clergy; and again when the cholera visited Quebec in 1849 and 1854 he was diligent in visiting the hospitals. During many years and up to the time of his death, Bishop Mountain, besides his life membership, contributed regularly to the Society a donation equal to four annual subscriptions, and at all times took a great interest in its proceedings.


