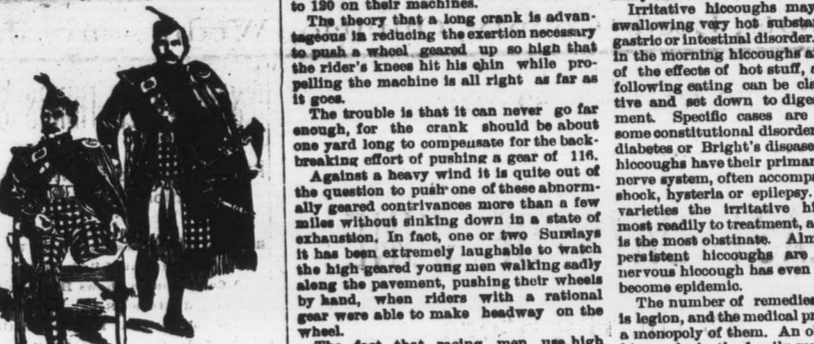


Illustration of a steam locomotive pulling a passenger train through a landscape.

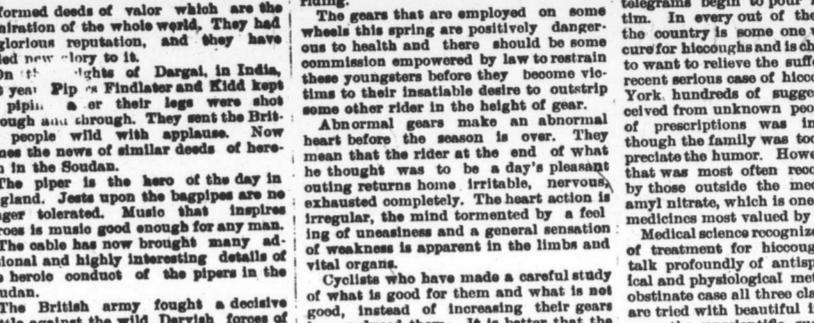

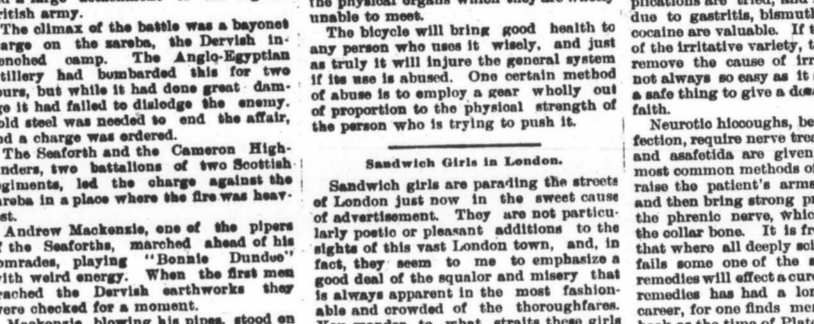
