The actual figures of the division on the second reading of the home rule bill are interesting. The house contains 670 members, and at present there are no vacant seats. Allowing for the speaker and two tellers on each side, the absentees numbered only fourteen. The exact parliamentary strength, according to the official figures, is as follows:
