

THE FERRY BOAT PITCH-IN

SOMETHING MORE ABOUT THE FERRY COLLISION IN TORONTO.

The Witnesses Examined Yesterday Before the Commissioners... The official investigation of the collision between the steamers Gertrude, Sadies and Queen City in Toronto Harbor on the night of Sept. 12 last was concluded yesterday afternoon at the Steamboat Inspection Office at the Custom House.

Samuel McCaig, holder of a master's certificate for Toronto Bay and vicinity, deposed that on the night of Sept. 12, 1887, he was on the Queen City as captain on Sept. 12. Witness ran two trips to King's Exhibition in the evening and one at night. He had to that day been employed as mate of the John Hanlan, a steamer belonging to the same line. The Queen City left Exhibition Wharf at about 9 o'clock. The Gertrude left more than an hour earlier, but called at Brock-street wharf, and was called the Queen City overtook her. There were fifty passengers on the Queen City. The Gertrude was 500 yards away from the Queen City and 50 yards off the sailing course when witness observed her. He saw the Gertrude's green light and a bright light at. At the same time he saw the Queen City's red light. There were no signals given.

When the Queen City gave the first signals the Gertrude was heading on her course to make the landing. The Gertrude was nearly abreast and a little ahead of the Queen City at the inside of the time. The Sadies arrived by two whistles, and the Gertrude gave one short blast immediately after. Witness gave the bell to reverse the engines and started to back up. The Queen City struck the Gertrude on the starboard quarter. The rule for passing when meeting and one was to stop the vessel. Witness did not do this, but put the wheel to starboard. The boat's head was to port. He saw no one in the water. He understood to sail the vessel without a mate. He thought he had done so safely in the dark and with fifty passengers on board. 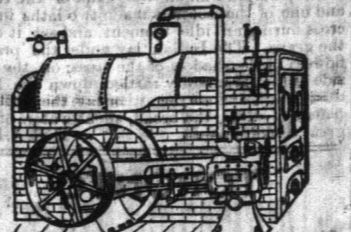
