MACKENZIE after being disarmed by the authorities in Buffalo and not unlike the haughty ancient Vulcan after being kicked out of heaven, is setting up his fortress on Navy Island, a few miles above Chippeway on the British side of the channel directly opposite the lower end of Grand Island, a place we are informed possessing many war like advantages, his forces are reported to be about two hundred strong with two field pieces, this island was once fortified by the French and next by the British in the last war with the United States, access to it would be very difficult except from the lower end of Grand Island which belongs to the United States, the channel running directly between the two, we would also state and we believe from good authority that he Mackenzie is assisted or accompanied by the son of General Van Renssler and nephew to Stephen Van Renssler, member of the United States Senate, the family is very respectable and very extensively wealthy, this we say from our own personal knowledge, but he will not stay with him long unless he has lost his
