Niagara, Monday Morning, Dec. 18th.

1857

The patrons of the Niagara Reporter will not be surprised at not having received their regular files, when they learn that it is for one of the very best reasons that could be assigned, viz. the Proprietor, Editor, and all hands, being absent from home and under Arms in defence of their Country. much has heretofore been said about mock Loyalty, but I think a very few specimens of such Loyalty as exhibited by the Proprietor, Editor, and all the men engaged in this office will forever establish that purity and patriotic zeal which was so fully and clearly developed on Thursday last, by their shouldering their muskets and marching off with a quick step and cheerful countenance which is always characteristic of a true Brittan—scarcely having time to say to the family, good by—to smith take care of my office—take the Editorial chair and do the best you can,—I am going to Fort Erie

MACKENZIE, after being disarmed by the authorities in Buffalo and not unlike the heathenish ancient Vulcan after being kicked out of heaven, is setting up his fortress on Navey Island, a few miles above Chippeway on the British side of the channel directly opposite the lower end of Grand Island, a place we are informed possessing many war like advantages, his forces are reported to be about two hundred strong with two field peices, this island was once fortified by the French and next by the British in the last war with the United States, access to it would be very difficult except from the lower end of Grand Island which belongs to the United States, the channel running directly between the two, we would also state and we believe from good authority that he Mackenzie is assisted or accompanied by the son of General Van Renssler and nephew to Stephen Van Renssler, member of the United States Senate, the family a very respectable and very extensively wealthy, this we say from our own personal knowledge, but he will not stay with him long unless he has lost his

penance—money he does not want and honor he cannot get but, vice versa, with a tenfold vengeance if he is ever caught on this side of the line.

N. B. Since writing the above we are informed by a gentleman direct from Chippewa in whom we can place confidence, confirming the above statement with this addition, that he intends crossing at Navy Island, Gravelly bay, or landing at the mouth of Grand river, and to accomplish his object is preparing a steamer at Buffalo
