

PUPILS FEEL REASSURED

How the Board Will Recoup itself for Dismissal of the Collegiate Institute Board last night it was revealed that each pupil paying the entrance examination this year should be charged the sum of \$1. The resident pupils fee is increased by the sum of \$3 and the non-resident pupils by \$5 for the academic year.

By these two changes the board hopes to realize about \$3000 with which to help to tide over the difficulty caused by the loss of the \$5000 which the Executive Committee topped of their estimates.

Mr. R. L. Patterson fathered a resolution to the effect that the treasurer be empowered to arrange with the Bank of Commerce to overdraft the board's account to a sum not exceeding \$5700, to be repaid as soon after January, 1939, as it was possible to obtain a supplementary grant from the city.

The object of the resolution was to cover the amount that the city struck from the board's estimates, leaving the amount as a deficit to be made up by the board.
