Be it remembered, that on the twenty-third day of May, in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, JOHN BRUCE, CHARLES SECRETAN, and JAMES PRENDERGAST, Clerks in the Customs at the Port of Quebec, have deposited in this Office, the Title of a Work, the Title of which, is in the words following, that is to say:—"THE QUEBEC COMMERCIAL LIST," the right of which, they claim as Proprietors.

Entered according to Act of the Provincial Legislature, intituled, "An Act for the protection of Copy Rights," by Perrault and Burroughs, Prothonotary of His Majesty's Court of King's Bench for the District of Quebec.
