## An Act to amend the Naturalization Act.

HER Majesty, by and with the advise and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The last eight lines of Section 11 of *The Naturalization Act*, chapter 113 of the Revised Statutes, are hereby repealed R.S.C., c. 113, s. 11 amended. and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:—

“ Such presentation shall be made in open court by the alien, personally or by his solicitor in his presence, on the first day of some general sitting of such court; and thereupon such court shall cause it to be openly read in court and shall examine the alien on the contents of the said oath; and if satisfied with the evidence, and that the alien comprehends the nature of his act, such court shall, on the last day of such sitting, direct that such certificate be filed of record in the court.”
