GIGANTIC ROBBERY CHARGED.

Railways Have Robbed U.S. of Seventy Millions in Carrying Mails Says Missouri. Washington, D.C., March 5.—The startling charge that the railroads of the country carrying the mails had robbed the post office of \$70,000,000 was made in the House of Representatives by Mr. Lloyd of Missouri, yesterday. He declared that the new system of weighing the mails was an admission of the postmaster-general that the weighing in the last 27 years had been fraudulent. He called for an investigation of the post office department and Mr. Wagner, of Pennsylvania, chairman of the committee to control the expenses of that department, promised that an inquiry would be conducted.

May Invoke Lemieux Act.
