## RULES AND REGULATIONS.

"The Membere of the Agricultural Societies of the severa! Townships within the County or United Countiea wherein the Annual Exhibition may be held, and the members of the said county or United Counties, shall be also members of the Assoeiation for that year, and have badges accordingly: provided the Agricultural Societies of the said Townships, or the Societies of the said County or United Countien, shall devote their whole funds for the yenr inoluding the Government Grant, in the aid of the Assooiation. The Offico-bearers of all County Societies chall have have badgos of free entrance during the Shวw.'-By-Lavo.

1. The payment of 5 s . and upwards constitutes a person a member of the Agricultural Association of Upper Canada for one year; and £2 10 s for lifo, when given for that speeifie objeot, and not as a contribution to the local funds.
2. No one but a member will bo allowed to compete for prizes except in classes $31,33,35$ and 36.
3. All Entries must be made on printod forme, which may be obtained of the Secretaries of Agricultural Societies, free of charge. These forms are to bo filled up and signed by the exhibitor, enelosing a dollar for membership, and sent to the Secretary of the Associntion, Board of Agriculture, Toronto, on on defore Saturdar, Sevi. C., after rehich time a charge of 5 s. sill be imposed on each articlc.

Exhibitors in the Horticultural and Ladies' Departments may enter articles up to Tuesday Evening, Sept. 23., when the Books will be finally closed.

Blood IIorses and Thorough-bred Catlle must be entered, and have thoir full Pedigrees properIy attestod and sent to the Secretary in Toronto, not later than Saturday, sept. 6th. No animala will be allowed to compete as pure bred, unlees they possess regular Stud and IIerd Book pedigrees, or satisfactory evidenco be produced that they are directly desconded from such stock. All animals entered in the Stock Register, kept by the Board, will be nllowed to competo without further enquiry.
4. Cards from the Treasurer's Office will be furnished each member, which will admit himsolf only, free to every department of tho Exhibition, during the Show. Lifo members ndmitted free.
5. Tiekets of almission to those who aro not members, 1 s 3 d each time of ntmis ion. Children under 14 yenrs of age, half price. Carriages, including drivers, 5 s ; passengers to pay 1s 3 d each. IIorsemen to pay 2 s 6d each admission.
6. Every article exhibited for competition must be tho growth, produce, or manufacture of Canada, except Classes 35 and 30 . Live Stock for breeding must he the property of persons residing in Cannda. All premiums for articles, except Stook, nre to be awarded to the mannficturers or producers only.
7. Disoretionary Premiums will be awarded for sueh articles as may be considered worthy by the Judges, although not enumerated in the List, and the Direetors will determine the amount of premium.
8. In the nbsence of compotition in any of tho Classes, or if the Stock or articles exhibited be of inforior quality, the Judges will exercise their diseretion as to the value of the promiums they recommend.
9. The Judges, Conpetitors, and Officers of the Association only will be permitted to enter the Show Grounds, until 12 o'olock, on Wednesday, at which hour Members will be admitted. Non Members will be admitted on Thursday and Friday mornings after $80^{\prime}$ clock.
10. No articles or Stock exhibited will be allowed to be remorod from the grounds, till the awards are made, without the permission of the President, under the penalty of losing the premiums. An Auctioneer will be on tho ground after the promiums are announced and every facility offorded for the transaction of business.
11. Delegates, Judges and Members of the Press, are requested and expected to report themselvos at the Secretary's Office immediately on their arrivnl.
12. The Judges are to meet at the Secretary's Office on the Grounds, on Wednesday morning, at 9 o'clock precisely, to make arrangements for entering upon their duties.
13. Arrangensents will be made for Agricultural Lectures or Discussiors during the evenings of Wednesday and Thursday of the Show week.
14. While the Directors will take every possible precaution, under the circumstances, to ensure the safety of articles sent to the exhibition, yet they wish it to bo distinetly understood that the orners of the articles must themselves take the risk of exhibiting them; and that should any article be accidentally injured, lost or atolen, the Directors will give all the assistanco in their power towards the recovery of the same, but will not make any payment for the value thercof.
15. Tho 'Treasurer will be prepared to commence paying tho premiume immediatoly after the successful competitors have been declared, and parties who shall have prizes awarded them are purticularly requested to apply for them before lonving Kingston, or loave a written order with some person to receive them, stating tho articles for which prizes are claimed.
The Local Committee will make arrangements with Steamboat and Railroad proprictors for carrying articles and passengers at reduced rates: also with the 1 Io:el and Boarding-house keepers, for accommodating visitors at their ordinary fixod charges. Full particulars will bo published hereafter in Show Bills.
N.B.-The President of the Association has kindly promised to supply IIny gratuitously to horses, cattle, and sheep during tho Eshibition.

These Reports, in addition to the usunl information required respectlng the condition of Agrienttural Socictios within their rnnge, should desoribe the various soils of the county, modes of farmiog, valuc of land, amount of tilligo und average of crops, breeds of live stook, implements and machine in use, manures and their modo of applioation, sketch of past progress, with suggestions for fur-: ther inprovement.

All statistical lnformation should be condensed, and, when practicable, put in a tnbulated form. The main object of the Report should be to afford nny intelligent stranger who may read it, a concire, yet an adequately truthful view of the agricultwiol condition and industrial pursuits of the County. It is desirable that each lieport shonld not be lewe thnn 25 or 30 octavo pages, wien printed.

The Reports aro to be sent in to the Seoretary of the lionrd of Agriculture, I'oronts, on or boforo tho 1st day of September next; accompsaiod by a sculed note containing the name nul nddrem of the writer. Sach as oltain premiuns will become thi property of tho Board; but no premium will bo a warded to any Report unless it possesses euffioiont merit, although it may be tho hest sent lin.
