Dr. O'Reilly Gets a Cablegram from

Col. Ashmun St. John

Dr. O'Reilly, Oct. 15.—Considerable

excitement has been excited by the

circumstances: Late on Sunday

night the Rev. Dr. Charles O'Reilly,

treasurer of the National League

received a cablegram from London,

the shortly afterward he was around a

second time by a messenger and a

telegram from Chicago was delivered to

him. Dr. O'Reilly arose and the tele-

grams were between his residence and

the home of Col. John Ashmun, the

patriot, were kept hot for nearly an

hour.

What passed between the gentlemen

is unknown, but at 7 o'clock yesterday

morning Dr. O'Reilly and Col. Ashmun

started for New York to take the steamer

for London.

It is understood they go to Europe to

confer with Parnell and other leaders

of the Irish movement and it is even

highly probable that they will be

in London on Sunday and several im-

portant cases in court will necessarily

be postponed on account of Col. Ashmun's

absence.
