HOT WEATHER MORTALITY

DEATHS IN THE FOUR CITIES
GENERALIZED SINCE JULY 1

IT is this number of deaths from the heat of the weather which has been the cause of the mortality in the four cities. The hot weather of July has had the effect of greatly swelling the death rate of the fairer part of the population. The mortality records, and is enabled now to present the mortality with the following epitome of its features.

The total deaths during the period were 1,060, or 50 per cent. more than in any other month of the year. THE SEWARD OIL COMPANY SUE THE BURNING OIL

Two Large Warehouses, Three Immense Tanks, Four Five Piers and About Ten Thousand Barrels of Oil Fall a Victim to the Flames.

New York, July 20.—Half a million dollars' worth of property of the Standard Oil Company disappeared in smoke early this morning. One of the largest fires that has yet visited the gigantic corporation at Constable Hook, N.J., broke out fifteen minutes after midnight. Two large warehouses, three immense tanks, four five piers and about ten thousand barrels of oil were destroyed by the destroying element, leaving nothing but a smouldering mass of ruins.
