The Department of External Affairs announced today that Prime Minister Mohammed Ali of Pakistan, accompanied by Begum Mohammed Ali, will arrive in Ottawa on Thursday afternoon, October 21, for a brief visit as a guest of the Canadian Government. The Prime Minister of Pakistan will reach Rockcliffe Airport from Washington at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday. A dinner will take place that evening at Government House.

On Friday morning October 22 Mr. Mohammed Ali will call on the Prime Minister of Canada and will later hold a press conference in the main conference room of the East Block. The High Commissioner for Pakistan will entertain at a reception late Friday afternoon at the Country Club. In the evening the Prime Minister of Pakistan and Begum Mohammed Ali will give a dinner in honour of His Excellency the Governor General. The Prime Minister and Begum Mohammed Ali will leave for New York on Saturday morning, October 23.
