The Mayor was in a very jubilant frame of mind when he reached his office yesterday morning. "I am more than delighted," he exclaimed, "at the success that has attended the opening of the new City Hall. Everything went off without a hitch, and it redounds greatly to the credit of the citizens of Toronto that, with the thousands of visitors who thronged the buildings yesterday, not a dollar's worth of damage was done."

They Have a Grievance. Mayor Shaw received yesterday a copy of a resolution passed by the Dominion Labor Council, objecting strenuously to the reduction in number of its representatives on the Technical School Board. A letter accompanying the resolution says that a special committee has been instructed to wait upon the City Council for the purpose of prosecuting their right if the council refused to accept the reduction.

Ask a Hearing. Messrs. Moir and McCall, carpenters, who improved the old Armoury for the Dominion Cold Storage Company, write through their solicitors, Kerr, Macdonald, Davidson and Paterson, stating that the city has benefited to the extent of \$800 through the work they did on the building, and they would like to place their claim before the Board of Control. The matter, they think, can be easily settled if the architect will attend.

DREYFUS' PARDON IS SURE. Council of Ministers Decided Upon It Yesterday—Dreyfus Relinquishes His Appeal. PARDON TAKES EFFECT SHORTLY. French People Took It Calmly—Belief That Dreyfus Will Be Secretly Sent Away. Paris, Sept. 19.—The Council of Ministers to-day decided to pardon Dreyfus in principle. The pardon will take effect in a few days. Dreyfus has relinquished his appeal for a reversal of the judgment of the court-martial.

If Mayor Shaw got the position, it would be necessary for Council to elect a man to fill his place for the balance of his term, and being so near election time, the deal would be fresh in the minds of the electors, and consequently the action of the Mayor would be remembered next January. In view of this, he thought they would think twice before taking any steps in the matter.
