SECOND EDITION. THE GREAT STRIKE.

NO GROUNDS FOR HOPE OF SETTLEMENT YET.

Ship Owners and the Company to Accept Yesterday's Proposal that Owners Employ their Own Men.

BY TELEGRAPH TO THE GAZETTE.

LONDON, September 3.—There is nothing in the strike situation this morning to inspire the hope of an immediate settlement of the questions at issue between the dockmen and the dock companies.

A separation of shipowners headed by Sir Donald Currie, waited upon the officials of the companies again today and urged the acceptance of yesterday's proposal to allow the ship owners to employ their own men to load and unload vessels.

The dock companies replied that they could not accept this proposition, but would be willing to enter into further discussions.

Mr. Donald said he regretted that a definite answer could not be given to the ship owners, but expressed his willingness to consent to join the conference.

The dock officials will express their views in writing for submission to the ship owners at a meeting later in the day.

The result of this conference destroys all chance of arriving at a settlement of the strike to-day and embitters the feeling of the men.

The chairman of the trade council in congress at Dundee, in its address devoted to the seething discontent prevalent among the working classes, owing to the economic and political conditions of the time, and the unequal distribution of the fruits of labor, he advocated the adoption of a legislative enactment making eight hours a day's work as a step in the right direction.
