

THE CROPS OF ONTARIO. ureau of IndustriesReport for July.

The July Report of the Bureau of dustries gives a summary of the conditi-on of grain, hay, and fruit crops in On-tario, together with statistics of acreage of grain crops and estimates of produce, and of the year's clip of fine and coarse

Mr. Francis Peck said he had trees which averaged a barrel selling for \$1.50 His favories were the Snow, Astracan, St. Lawrence, and Talman Sweets. He had good trees, and considered the Gol-den Russet the best winter apple. A new variety, a vigorous grower and a good keeper, was the Star. Mr. W. R. Dempsey gave his recom-mendation in favor of the Calvert as a full apple. Everything, he said, depend ed on the cultivation of the soil. Mr. J. B. Williams placed the Golden Russet at the head of the list. The President was of opinion that ap-ples would flourish on. The trouble was that people took either too light or too heavy soil. Mr. Young said the first requisite was a naturally dry soil. Mr. Burnished in low wet soil. Mr. Burn said the orchard would pay just in proportion to the care bestowed on it.


