ON CANADIAN COPYRIGHT.

Attorney of the Copyright Association of Canada.

Decides Action Taken—A Full Discussion of the Subject and a Draft Bill Prepared by the Copyright Association of Canada.

A general meeting of the Copyright Association of Canada was held on Thursday evening, the 18th inst., at the Board of Trade room, Toronto, Mr. J. Ross Robertson, the president, in the chair.

In opening the meeting, the chairman briefly reviewed the situation, showing that the Bill, which had been introduced at the last session of parliament, threatened the most disastrous consequences to the book, printing and publishing interests of Canada.

The revised constitution provided an admirable scheme for the book, printing and publishing interests of Canada, without requiring any change in the law as it stands.

The draft of the Bill adopted. A rough draft of a bill containing suggestions for the practical operation of the new Dominion Copyright Act, governing the reprinting in Canada of imperial copyright works.

The following is a brief synopsis of the clauses of most interest to the trade and the public: Sec. 1 defines copyright in Canada as the United States copyright law as it stands in Canada.

Sec. 2 recites that the condition for obtaining the Canadian copyright shall be that the work shall be printed and published in Canada within a certain time after its first publication elsewhere.

Sec. 3 recites that any work intended to be copyrighted in Canada shall be deposited with the Minister of Agriculture in duplicate, and that the author or his legal representative shall register the work with the Minister of Agriculture.

Sec. 4 recites that the author or his legal representative shall be entitled to a certificate of registration, which shall be evidence of the author's right to the copyright.
