HOUSEHOLD RECEIPTS.

TURKEY ROASTED.—Do not dress a turkey until it has been killed four or five days. Stuff it as follows;—Mix about four ounces of fine bread crumbs with the same weight of nicely minced beef suet or butter, a bit of lemon peel, a little parsley and sweet herbs, some pepper and salt, and a small onion finely chopped; bind them together with one or two eggs, and, if you like, add a little sausage meat; stuff it into the craw; make some into balls, and put round the dish. Put a sheet of nice paper over the breast, dredge it with flour, put it down to roast and baste it with butter. When nearly done dredge and baste it again and take the paper off. Three hours will be required for a large turkey, and two hours for one of a middling size; a small one less; send up with pork sausages, gravy sauce, mushroom, oyster or egg sauce, &c. If turkeys are baked, a bit of butter should be sent with them for basting.

PLAIN BUNS.—Take one pound of flour, and well mix with it two ounces of good butter, two ounces of Jamaica sugar, a little grated nutmeg, some powdered ginger, and any other spice in powder that you may choose. Add a spoonful of cream to two ounces of yeast; and make the whole into a light paste, with the addition of as much milk as may be requisite. Place it near the fire till it ferments; then divide it into buns of the size you choose, and let them be baked in a quick oven.

EEL PIE.—Skin and clean some good-sized eels thoroughly, cut off the heads and tails and put them by. Cut the eels into convenient pieces, season them with pepper and salt, and lay them in a pie-dish covered with thin paste; add a little water or broth; cover the dish with crust and bake it. Make gravy of the heads and tails with a little broth, season it, add a little lemon juice, thicken it with butter and flour, and pour it into the pie.

Other Fish Pies may be made in the same way as the above, adapting the seasoning to the fish.

HOUSEHOLD RECEIPTS.

WOODCOCK OR SNIPE.—Do not draw them; let them be roasted over a toast in a dish, with the breasts larded with bacon. Serve up on the toast with melted butter. Fifteen minutes will roast a snipe and twenty a woodcock.

PHEASANT OR PARTRIDGE.—Both are dressed the same way. They should be hung some days, and basted with butter when roasted. Twenty minutes or half an hour will roast them, according to size. Serve with good gravy and bread sauce.

DUCK.—Stuff it in the same way as a goose, with broiled sage and onion chopped fine, bread crumbs, butter, salt, pepper, and the yolk of an egg; roast it before a good fire three-quarters of an hour. Send up gravy, green peas, and onion sauce.

SAGE AND ONION SAUCE.—Boil one or two small onions with a few sage leaves until they are tender; take them out and chop them fine; add some fine bread crumbs to the water, with pepper and salt, and pour a small quantity of good gravy or melted butter into it. Stir the whole well together and let it simmer a few minutes.

RABBIT OR HARE PIE.—Cut up the hare or rabbit fit to serve at table, stew it in a small quantity of water with some sweet herbs, an onion chopped and some allspice; when half done, take it up and put it into a pie-dish lined with paste, with force-meat balls, slices of lemon, and the yoke of a hard egg or two; add some of the liquor the hare was stewed in, cover it with paste and bake it an hour.

PIES OF POULTRY AND GAME are made in a similar manner to the above, except that appropriate seasoning is required for each.

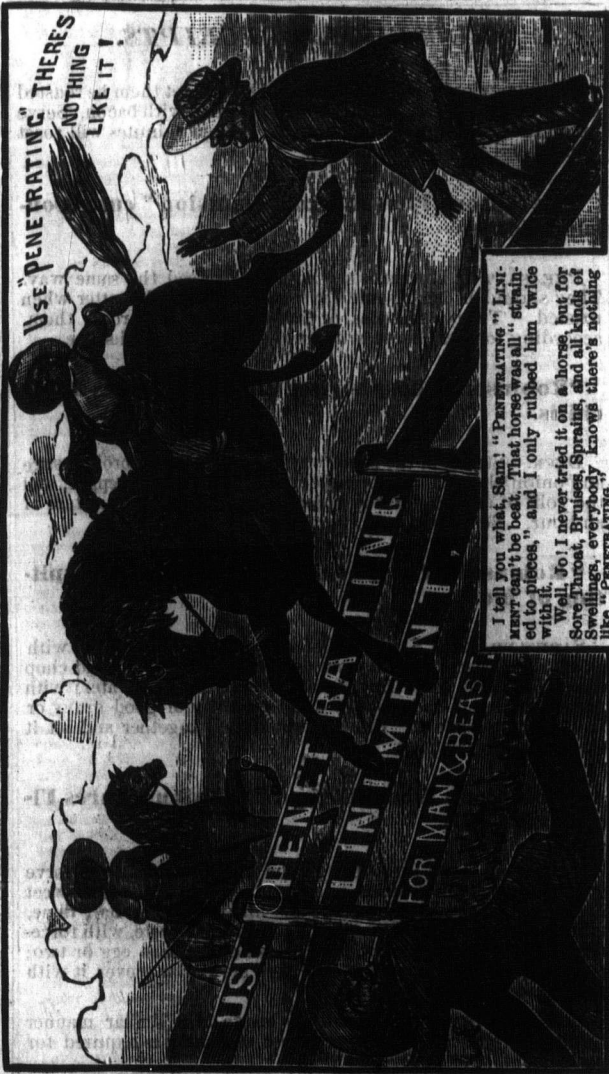

HOUSEHOLD RECEIPTS.

PIGEON PIE.—Clean the pigeons, put a little pepper and salt and a bit of butter into the insides of them; line the dish with paste; put a rump steak at the bottom of it and lay the pigeon on the steak, with the gizzards, necks, and the yolks of two or three eggs boiled hard, between them; add a little gravy or water, cover it with crust, and bake it an hour and a half.

A PASTE FOR MEAT PIES, &c.—Rub together two pounds of flour and three-quarters of a pound or more of good salt butter; beat up one or two eggs and mix with it; add water to make a proper paste, and roll out thin as before directed.

APPLE DUMPLINGS.—Cut the apples in half, and take out the core; replace it by a clove, or a bit of lemon peel; put them together again and put a thin paste round them, made as directed for apple pudding; tie them in pudding cloths or not, as you like. They will be done in an hour.

Apple dumplings thus made are very good *baked*.

SUET PUDDING OR SUET DUMPLINGS.—Chop a pound of suet fine, and mix it with the same quantity of flour, two or three eggs, a little salt, and enough milk to mix it properly. Boil it four hours; or make it into dumplings, and boil them two hours.

BREAD PUDDING.—Soak some thin slices of bread in boiling water; beat up two or three eggs with the bread; add a little sugar and nutmeg, and tie the pudding up in a basin with a floured cloth; boil it an hour.

HOUSEHOLD RECEIPTS

CUSTARD PUDDINGS (quickly made).—Beat four eggs, and strain them; mix four ounces of flour very smoothly with a pint of milk; add to it the eggs and strain it again; flavor the batter with sugar and nutmeg; butter some teacups, fill them three parts full, put them in an oven, and they will be done in a quarter of an hour, and if well mixed, will be equal to custard.

APPLE PIE.—Pare and cut some good apples into quarters, core them and put them close together in a pie dish; pound some good moist sugar with some grated lemon peel, and put over the apples; add two or three cloves. Cover it with good puff paste, and bake it an hour and a quarter.

BATTER PUDDING.—Beat up three eggs, mix them well with milk, and six ounces of flour; make it quite smooth and of the thickness of cream. Tie it up tight in a buttered basin, and boil it an hour and a half.

Batter pudding is also baked under meat, or, the meat being seasoned and cut into pieces, may be stirred into it with chopped onion. Bake it in a slow oven.

HANINGTON'S FURNITURE POLISH gives a beautiful gloss to Furniture, and requires very little rubbing.

MUFFINS.—Mix two pounds of flour with two eggs, two ounces of butter melted in a pint of milk, and four or five spoonfuls of yeast, according to its thickness. Be it observed, that table beer yeast is best for such purposes, as ale yeast is apt to possess too much bitterness, from the greater quantity of hops used. Beat the flour, yeast, milk, etc., well together, and leave it three or four hours to rise. Bake on a hot hearth in fat cakes; when one side is done, turn them. They do not require long baking.

HOUSEHOLD RECEIPTS.

FRENCH BREAD.—To make this, take a quarter of a peck of fine flour, sifted; mix the yolks of three and the whites of two eggs, beaten and strained, a little salt, half a pint or less of good yeast that is free from bitterness, and as much milk made a little warm as will work the flour into a thin light dough. Stir it well about, but do not knead it. Have ready three wooden bowls or dishes, which will each hold about a quart; divide the dough, putting some into each of them, and set it to rise; then put them in tins the size you choose, and bake them in a quick oven. When done rasp them.

A CHEAP PUDDING.—Take half a pound of flour, half a pound of currants, half a pound of suet well chopped, and four ounces of treacle, with milk sufficient to mix it into a paste or stiff batter; butter a basin, put it in, and when tied in a cloth, let it boil five hours. When cold it may be cut into slices and browned in the pan.

RUSKS.—Take nineteen eggs; first beat the whites, and then beat the yolks with one pound and a half of loaf sugar in powder. Mix the whole, adding one pound and a half of flour and a few caraway seeds, if you like their flavor. Fill some in buttered moulds, and bake them. Cut in slices, and put them again in the oven to brown.

ROLLED PUDDING.—Make a paste as for a pie; roll it out in a long strip, cover it equally over with currants and chopped apples; roll it up, tie it in a cloth and boil it. In serving it up, cut it in slices; add melted butter for those who choose it, which will not be many. This pudding may also be made with any preserved fruit or jam, or even with treacle, and a little chopped apple.

HOUSEHOLD RECEIPTS.

HARD BISCUIT.—Warm two ounces of butter in as much skimmed milk as will wet a pound of flour sufficiently to make a very stiff paste. Beat it well with a rolling pin, and knead it very smooth. Roll it out thin, and cut it into biscuits. Prick them full of holes with a fork. About six minutes will bake them.

PLUM PUDDING SAUCE.—Mix a little pounded lump sugar with some melted butter; add a glass of sherry, a small glass of brandy, and a little nutmeg and lemon-peel grated.

A COMMON CHEAP CAKE.—Mix well together one pound and a half of flour, half a pound of butter or clarified lard, four ounces of sugar, and half a grated nutmeg. Make a hole in the middle of the flour, and set a sponge with a tea-cupful of yeast and a little warm milk. When it is well risen, add a little candied lemon or orange peel minced, and one egg well beaten. Mix the whole into a proper consistence with a little warm milk; set it to rise in a warm place, but not close to the fire, and when it has risen bake it. Seeds can be added if they are approved of, and spices or fruit also at pleasure.

BATH CAKES are very simple, and are suitable for the breakfast or tea table. They are thus made: Mix one pound of fresh butter with a pound of flour, rubbing it well in; then make it into a paste with a gill of yeast and some warm cream. Set it near the fire till it ferments; and when it has well risen make it into cakes, sprinkling in a few caraway seeds if you choose. Form it into cakes about the size of rolls, and bake them on tins.
