


Jeseph Hallman's Old Homestead in Blenheim Tp. At present owned by George Hallman.





A Brief History and Chronology of the Descendants of Benjamin Hallman (D), son of Benjamin Hallman (C), who was the son of Henry Hallman (B), who was the son of Anthony Hallman (A).

Anthony Hallman, Great Grand father of Benjamin Hallman, the history of whose descendants is traced in the tollowing pages, was a resident of Skippack Township, Montgomery County,

Pa., probably as early as 1708, where he owned a farm of about 150 acres. (See picture). According to the records given, he was born in the year 1671. He was a member of the

Augustus Lutheran Church, Trappe, Pa., and was one of the building committee of this Church in 1743 which building is still standing. (See picture below). Over one of the doors of the Church building is a stone containing the names of the building committee, and his name is given in Latin: "A. Heilmano."

He made his will January 25th, 1759, and it is recorded in book L., page 301, in the Register of Wills office in Philadelphia, Pa.

The following is an abstract of the same, giving the important items contained therein:

"I hereby disinherit my son John for reasons best known to himself, save one English shilling, to be paid within ten days after my death. I give unto my oldest daughter Dorothy Heizer, wife of John Heizer (Heiser) the sum of £500. I give unto my second daughter Christiann Leffeber (Lefeber) the sum of £500. I give unto my third daughter Catharine Kressman (wife of John Cressman) £500. I give unto my three grandsons Leonard, Valentine and George, my daughter Mary Salome Perkymer's children (Berkheimer) the sum of £1 13.4. I give unto my daughter Barbara Jacobs the sum of £5. I give unto my youngest daughter Anna Maria Ketchy, the minister's wife (Rev. John Henry Goetschius) the sum of £5. I give unto my youngest son Henry Hallman all my household goods, chattels, husbandry implements, &c., also my land in Skippack, about 150 acres."

His son, Henry Hallman, was appointed sole executor of the estate under the will. The witnesses to the will were Deter Melchor, Jacob (?) and Charles Cornelius Raboteau. The will was probated August 3, 1759.

The maiden name of Anthony Hallman's wife is not known, but her given name was Mary Salome. She died in September 1745, at the age of 43 years, and was buried at the Trappe Church, September 26, 1745.

Anthony Hallman died in July 1759 at the age of 88 years, and was buried at the Trappe Church, July 16, 1759. At the time of his death he was warden of the Augustus Lutheran Church, Trappe, Pa., of which Rev. Henry Melchor Muhlenberg was pastor.

They had eight children:

- 7. (b) Anna Maria, married to Rev. John Henry Goetschy.

8. (b) **Henry,** married twice. The name of his first wife is not given. The name of his second wife was Anna Maria Bersons.

We give here a brief record of the other children, though the youngest son Henry is the one in the direct line of the Ancestors of the Hallmans whose history is given in these pages.

John 1. (b) the eldest, was married and had six children, whose names were as follows:

He purchased a farm of Mary Norris in 1736, (f 172 acres in Worcester Township. In 1763 he sold this farm to his nephew, Leonard Berkheimer, and purchased a mill in Gwynedd Township. He also followed the trade of blacksmith. He was a contributer to the salary of pastor Muhlenberg in 1760. This is all that is known of John.

The descendants of Dorothy, Christiana and Catharine have not been traced.

The descendants of Barbara and Anna Maria have not beer traced.

Henry, 8. (b) the youngest son, as stated in the will, inherited his father's farm in Skippack Township, and resided on it all his lifetime. As far as can be found out from the records, he was a member of the Augustus Lutheran Church, and his name is found as one of the contributors to pastor Muhlenberg's salary in 1760. He was married twice. The name of his first wife is not known, neither can we find out how many of his children belong to his first wife. His family are buried at the Old Mennonite Cemetery in Skippack Township. The following were probably the names of the children of his first wife:

His second wife died December 5th, 1792, aged 58 years and 2 months. He, himself, died at the age of 87 years and 5 months.

A brief history of Henry Hallman's children is given as folows:

18. (c) **Anna Catharine Hallman**, was confirmed by Rev. Schultz, in Augustus Lutheran Church, Trappe, Pa., April 12, 1752, at the age of 13 years.

19. (c) **Anna Christina Hallman**, was confirmed March 30th, 1755, at the age of 14 years. She was married May 16th, 1758, to Jacob Schneider. (Descendants, if any, have not been traced).

21. (c) **Jacob Hallman**, born June 12, 1757; died April 20th, 1823. He lived on his father's farm in Skippack Township. He belonged to Capt. Daniel Springer's Company of Militia in 781.

22. (c) **Benjamin Hallman**, was a member of Capt. Barnet Haine's Company of Militia in 1777. Served as ensign in 1781. He was a shoemaker by trade and lived in Upper Providence Township, Montgomery County, Pa. He was married to Anna (or Fronica) Gotwals. They had thirteen children, and their names were as follows:

Most of the members of the Hallman family in Canada are descendants of 43 (d) Benjamin and Elizabeth (Detwiler) Hallman, the youngest son of Benjamin Hallman (22). A small number of the family in Canada are descendants of 33 (d) Joseph and Margaret (Fry) Hallman.

43 (d) Benjamin Hallman, was born September 18th, 1783, in Perkiomen Township, Montgomery County, Pa., where he followed farming. During the great financial depressions from 1816 until 1827 many of that calling in Montgomery and other counties failed financially, and in order to save their creditors from losing any money, the distressed farmers sold their farms at a great sacrifice and paid their debts, and with whatever little balance left they wended their way to Canada where land could be had cheap and thus made another attempt to gain a free home. And as a rule all these parties in a very few years were the possessors of valuable farms. Such was the case with Benjamin Hallman (13 d), our Canadian progenitor. He suffered financially during the great crisis as aforesaid, and finding things to his advantage, he moved to Canada with his family in 1825. They left Montgomery County, Pa., on the 6th day of May with two double horse teams and one single horse team. They crossed the Niagara River from Lewiston to Oueenston on a large "Flat Boat." Then they wended their way up to Dundas and through the Beverly Swamp to Waterloo County, arriving at Jacob Rosenberger's near Preston, where they made a stay of three days. Thence they moved on a farm two miles west of Waterloo. Here he resided until spring (1826) when he moved to North Dumfries Township, about one mile east of Roseville, where he had purchased a most reautiful farm of about 200 acres, then nearly all forest. This farm is now in possession of Ephraim, son of Menne H. Hallman. Here the old Grandfather died full of years, September 10th. 1800. He was a member of the Mennonite Church. and lived a strictly moral life. His principles of Christianity were always foremost in his dealings with his fellowmen. His advice to his grand children, of whom the writer was one, was always good. Our earliest recollection of him is when he held us on his knee and instructed us to be a good boy. Three of his sons and a number of Grand sons and Great Grand sons entered the ministry. On September 2nd, 1802, he was married to Elizabeth, daughter of Jacob and Margaret (Harley) Detweiler. She was born August 8th, 1784, and died August 9th, 1850. To them was born a numerous family, all of which were born in Mont_ gomery County, Pa., save the two youngest, Hannah and Wen

del, who were born in Waterloo County, Ontario. See picture of his homestead in front of book.

Children of Benjamin Hallman.

1. (e) Rev. Jacob Hallman, the eldest in the family, was born in Montgomery County, Pa., November 18th, 1803. In 1822 he, in company with Mr. Lutz, walked to Canada and made Waterloo County, Ontario, his home for about two years. He left on a Sunday afternoon without any money and only a little bundle of clothes. He earned his way as he went. When, after two years of a stay he had earned some money he returned home, where he remained till the following spring, when he persuaded his father and mother and remainder of the family to go back with him to Canada. Sometime after his arrival he was married to Eva, daughter of Christian and Polly (Ruth) Strome. She was born Sept. 9th, 1805, and died July 11th, 1886. Soon after their marriage they moved on their farm of about 200 acres, in Wilmot Tp., about two and one half miles north of New Dundee, where they resided until their deaths.

In 1837 he was called to the ministry of the Mennonite Church, which body he served faithfully for over forty years. His sermons were always plain practical, and accompanied with a strong appeal to the younger members of the congregation to live up to the teachings of the Scrip-His great tures. and only desire was that he might pass the rest of his days in the humble yet honorable service in the ministry of the

Lord, to which he was so sincerely attached. His companionship was always pleasant. Even in his last months of suffering, when the writer was privileged to take his turn with one of his grand sons, once a week to watch over him during the night, he always had an encouraging and instructive word for us boys. How blessed these memories are to those of us who are following them to the same future home. What lasting impressions for good they have left. He died March 23rd, 1878. His family consists of six children. (See 1-6 f).

2. (e) **Margaret Hallman**, was born August 31st, 1805 and died March 18th, 1884. She was married to Adam Unger, (born in Lancaster County, Pa.,) October 31st, 1824. In February, 1825, they moved to North Dumfries Township, on lot No. 3_2 , one mile east of Roseville, on a farm of about 150 acres, where they resided until their death. It was not the privilege of the writer to be as well acquainted with this his beloved aunt, as he was with some of the others. But, like the others in the family, she was firm in her principles of righteousness. They had a family of seven children. (See 7-13 f).

3. (e) **Maria Hallman**, was born September 10th, 1806, and died March 8th, 1873. She was married to Jacob Bechtel They resided in North Dumfries Township, Waterloo County, Ontario, near the old "Black Horse" hotel, where they owned a farm of about 150 acres, where he died. After his death she made her home with her daughter Catharine, who was married to Benjamin Snyder, where she died in the year

They were both members of the Mennonite Church, and to these principles they adhered till they died. She was a good mother, and always sought to instil into the minds and hearts of her family the noble and elevating principles of Christianity.

They had a family of fourteen children. (See 14-27 f).

4. (e) **Joseph Hallman**, was born September 15th, 1808. In 1831 he was married to Susannah, daughter of Henry M. and Sarah (Bergey) Clemmer. She was born December 29th, 1810, and died February 15th, 1854. In 1856 he was again married to Elizabeth, daughter of John Clemmer. She was born October 20th, 1820, and died March 27th, 1 86

again married to Magdalena, daughter of David and Elizabeth (Bechtel) Eby. She was born December 12th. 1813, and died April 2nd. 1886. After his first marriage he moved to Mann heim, on the farm now in possession of Peter Geiger, where he resided four years, then he moved on the farm now owned by Samuel Toman, a little west of New Dundee, the farm which was afterwards owned by his younger brother Wendell, where they


resided one year; then he moved to Blennheim Township, Oxford County, about one and a half miles south-west of New Dundee, on a large farm, where he lived till his death. His family consisted of twelve children, (See 28-41 f), all of whom, save the youngest, are of the first wife. He was one of those firm minded men of whom not a few were to be found among those old fathers who came from Pennsylvania. Though of a kindly disposition and high moral principles, when once his mind was made up, it was difficult for him to change it. He was a member of the Mennonite Church, and adhered strictly to these principles to his His life and conduct were such as would make an impresdeath. sion for good on his fellowmen and family. Though he was inclined, perhaps, to discount the views of others if they did not agree with him on religious lines, yet, we have reason to believe he was honest in his convictions. He lived on the old homestead in the residence shown on this page.

5. (e) **Catharine Hallman** was born September 28th, 1810, and died January 19th, 1889. She was married to Abra-

ham Bricker June 10th, 1830. They owned a large farm near Mannheim. (See picture on opposite page) where they lived for fifty-one years. In 1882 they made their home with their daughter Catharine (Mrs. I. Nahrgang) where she died. She was a member of the Mennonite Church, and was loyal to her convictions. As a mother she was always anxious for the welfare of her children, faithfully discharging the duties of a mother as far as she could. Their family consists of thirteen children. (See 42-54 f).

6. (e) **John Hallman** was born August 1st, 1812. He was married to Sallie Bergey, and resided near Mannheim, where



he owned a large farm of about 200 (See picacres. ture in front of He was book). a member of the Old Mennonite Church, and lived a quiet peaceable life. He was a farmer thrifty which occupation he followed until he retired. He lived on the old homestead in the residence shown on this page, until he died, March 13th, 1888. They had a large fama

7. (e) **Veronica Hallman**, was born May 14th, 1814, and died January 9th, 1894. She was married to William Hunsberger April 15th, 1834. After their marriage they moved on the lot lying next to the old "Grody Farm," north-west of the Schmidt Mennonite Meeting House, Wilmot Township, Waterloo County, Ontario, where they commenced in the woods. They remained there until in the spring of 1836, when they purchased a farm of about 150 acres one mile west of New Dundee. Here they resided until their deaths. The earliest recollections of this dear old aunt by the writer, are her kind words with which she always welcomed us as children to her home. She always had something to give to the children to make them happy. It was like going to one's own mother to come to her for comfort and advice. Strictly moral and upright in her life, she sought to teach her family according to her own convictions. Her admonitions to her own and others were always of a religious nature. Many a happy day did the writer spend at their home when a boy. They were both members of the Tunker (River Brethren) Church. He died March 2nd, 1895. They had a family of ten children. (See 73-82 f).

8. (e) **Elizabeth Hallman**, was born June 12, 1817, and died June 30th, 1883. She was married to Samuel Hunsberger (born September 6th. 1814, and died April 1905). They moved to the farm four miles north of New Dundee, now owned by Jacob S. Hallman (7 f) where they resided for a few years, and afterwards they purchased a farm one mile south and two miles west of New Dundee, where they resided until her death. The farm is at present owned by Benjamin Krupp, and the buildings are destroyed. The house as it appeared before it was burnt is seen in the picture in front of book. He had his home with Moses Toman of late years, where he died. They had a family of two children. (See 8_3 - 8_4 f).

9. (e) **Christian Hallman**, was born June 5th, 1820, and died April 27th, 1821.

10. (c) **Hannah Hallman**, twin sister to Christian, was born June 5th, 1820, and died August 23rd, 1820.

11. (e) **Rev. Benjamin Hallman**, was born September 20th, 1821. On January 24th, 1843, he was married to Catherine Honsberger who was born March 16th, 1824, and died November 30th, 1886. After his marriage he moved on his father's old homestead, about a mile cast of Roseville, where he still resides. Some years ago he was chosen to the ministry of the River Brethren denomination. Active, faithful, disinterested and selfsacrificing devotion for the teaching of that which he regards as truth and Gospel teaching, are marked features of his character. Like some others, his firmness and extreme conscientiousness would perhaps at times put a discount on the faith of othery who did not see eye to eye with him, but no one could doubt his sincerity and honesty. He has always been highly respected bs those who knew him best. He sought to teach his family the principles so prominently manifest in his own life, and to brinn them up in the fear of the Lord. His family consists of eleveg children. (See 85-95 f).



12. (f) **Christian Hallman**, was born in Montgomery County, Pa., October 25th, 1822. On March 4th, 1845, he was married to Leah Bechtel who was born June 23rd, 1823. After their marriage they resided in Wilmot Township, Waterloo County, where he was engaged as a contractor and builder, and during the winter months in weaving. In the year 1875 they moved to Hanover, Grey County, Ontario, where he now resides. They were both members of the Mennonite Church. They have a family of eleven children. (See 96-106 g). Reg. 26



His boyhood days were spent on his father's farm near Roseville. On February 13th, 1840, he was married to Nancy Schlichter who was born August 24th, 1820. Soon after their marriage they settled on a farm about a mile west of New Dundee, where they resided until March 20th, 1883, when they sold their farm and moved to Michigan, where he resided for some

years. In he moved to Berlin, Ontario, where he is still living. Nearly 40 years ago he was ordained to the ministry of the River Brethren (Dunkards) denomination. As a father he always sought to give his children wholesome advice. He was always very strict in training his children, sometimes we children thought perhaps a little too strict, but the writer at least does not think so now. As early as the writer can recollect, the family was gathered together every morning, and while we were all quietly seated father would read a chapter out of the Bible, followed by an earnest simple prayer. These moments made and left a deep impression on the minds of the children, and must certainly have been a source of strength to those who were followers of Christ. His most earnest desire has always been that all his children, might be saved. As a minister he is well liked by his congregation and others. A picture of his present home appears on this page. 1. (e) CHILDREN OF JACOB HALLMAN, THE ELDEST SON.

1. (f) **Samuel Hallman**, the eldest, was born May 5th, 1826. On March 21st, 1848, he was married to Mary Snyder who was born January 15, 1831. Shortly after their marriage they moved on their farm which is now owned by Josiah Cassel, on the township line between Wilmot and Blenheim. To them were born ten children. (See 1-10 g).

2. (f) **Jacob Hallman**, was born November 1827, and died, aged one day.

3. (f) **John S. Hallman**, was born June 8th, 1829. On July 18th, 1852, he was married to Mary Clemens who was born September 11th, 1834. They resided about two and one-half miles north of New Dundee, on his father's old homestead until the spring of 1890 when they moved to Berlin, where he died December 10th, 1893. To them were born twelve children. (See 11-22 g).

4. (f) Elizabeth Hallman, was born April 12th, 1832, and died June 25th, 1834.

5. (f) **Benjamin Hallman**, was born October 10th, 1835, and died April 15th, 1840.

6. (f) **Jacob S. Hallman**, was born June 26th, 1842. On October 21st, 1862, he was married to Catharine, daughter of Joshua Y. and Magdalena (Martin) Shantz. She was born October 1st, 1842. Soon after their marriage they moved on the farm now possessed by Charles Montag, about two miles south of Petersburg where they resided until January 7th, 1891, then he moved on the old "Hunsberger Farm" which he had previously purchased. His family consists of three children. (See 23-25 g).

CHILDREN OF MARGARET AND ADAM UNGER 2 (e).

7. (f) **John Unger,** was born in North Dumfries Township, September 10th, 1825. He was married to Polly, daughter of Wendel Bowman of Blair. He was a prosperous farmer, but since the death of his wife has lived a retired life. At present he resides in the town of Berlin, Ontario, with one of his daughters. Their family consists of eight children. (See 26-33 g).

8. (f) **Benjamin Unger**, was born October 3rd, 1826. He resided in the town of Galt, Ontario, where he, until his death, was engaged in business. His widow still resides in Galt. They have four children. (See 34-37 g). 9. (f) **Joseph Unger**, was married to Geraldina Broh man. They resided in the city of Toronto where he died in 1861 Their family consisted of two children. (See 38-39 g).

10. (f) **Catherine Unger**, is married to Wendel Clemens, a farmer. They reside near Brown City, Michigan. They have eleven children. (See 40-50 g).

11. (f) **Elizabeth Unger,** is married to Martin Grimm. They reside in Milverton, Perth County. Their family consists of five children. (See 51-55 g).

12. (f) **Moses Unger**, was born in North Dumfries. He was a prosperous farmer until several years ago when he retired. He resides at present near Preston. He is married to Magdalena Histand. Their family consists of twelve children. (See 56-67 g).

13. (f) **Hannah Unger**, is married to Jacob Bricker, a farmer. They reside near Fordwich, Howick Township, Huron County, and have a family of ten children. (See 68-77 g).

CHILDREN OF MARIA AND JACOB BECHTEL (3 e).

14. (f) Veronica Bechtel, died in infancy.

15. (f **John Bechtel**, was married to Sarah, daughter of Isaac and Sarah (Hembling) Woolner. She was born March 25th, 1828. They reside in northern Michigan, where he is engaged in building and contracting. They have a family of five children. (See 78-82 g).

16. (f) **Elizabeth Bechtel**, was married to George Eschelman. They resided on a farm three miles east of Roseville, where he died January 28th, 1889. They had a family of ten children. (See 83-92 g).

17. (f) **Catharine Bechtel**, was married to Benjamin D. Snyder. They moved to Kansas, where they were engaged in farming for some years. After retiring from farming they moved back to Canada, where she died in 1902. They had a family of six children. (See 93-98 g).

18. (f) **Sarah Bechtel**, was married to John Rickert. They resided near Mannheim, Waterloo County. They are both dead. They have a family of eight children. (See 99-106 g).

The friends gathered together in the grove soon after ten o'clock, and many were the warm hand shakes and the friendly greetings of relatives who had not met each other for years, and some had never seen each other. There was manifested that feeling of a real family tie.

There are only three of the Benjamin Hallman family living, viz.; Benjamin, who lives on the old Hallman homestead, Hannah (Mrs. Enoch Ziegler), and Wendell, both of whom reside in Berlin, Ontario. The latter two were present at the re-union, and this made it so much more impressive.

Religious services were held in the afternoon. The chairman called the friends together at two o'clock, and after singing and prayer Rev. Wendell Hallman spoke in German from John 1: 1-15. The following is an extract of a report of the afternoon services as it appeared in the "Berlin News Record."

"Interesting indeed, were the formal exercises -- simple though they were -- that were held on Thursday afternoon in Schneider's grove, in connection with the Hallman re-union. The ceremonies were largely of a religious nature, and were held in the open air where the general meetings during the Mennonite encampment were held. Between 600 and 700 Hallmans and blood and marriage connections, gathered there at two o'clock and gave the closest of attention for two hours while the speakers had the floor. Mr. J. C. Hallman, of New Dundee, the reunion president, ably acted as chairman, and with him on the platform were Rev. Wendell Hallman, the younges, son of the pioneer Hallman. He is now about 83 years old. Rev. Noah Stauffer, Strasburg; Rev. C. N. Good, Aylmer, and Rev. H. S. Hallman, Berlin, were also on the platform.

"Rev. Wendell Hallman was the honored speaker of the occasion, and he was given perfect attention. He spoke in the Pennsylvania German dialect, and expressed his pleasure at meeting so many of the family. Many he had never seen before, and many he would never see again. He would like to give them a message for the very best of all of the big gathering—something they would think of and be influenced by all the rest of their lives. And no message could be better than the simple story of Christ's love.

"He then read from John 1: 1-15, and at his request the gathering sang an old German hymn, a favorite of his. His text was based on the story of the uplifted serpent in the wilderness as a cure for the sin punished Israelites. He told them again the old, old story of Divine love and sacrifice, and his simple, earnest words were very impressive.

"Rev. C. N. Good, of Aylmer, was called on for a few words. He spoke in English, and spoke of the characteristics of the Hallman family as he had observed them. They have been a good physical, strong race; of a high moral calibre. It is the duty of those of the present day to live up to the noble principles of their ancestors. He closed by saying that the life of each should be one pleasing to God. A higher relationship than that of an earthly family is necessary — a membership in the family of the redeemed.

"Rev. Noah Stauffer, of Strasburg, was called on. In responding he said, there are no ties of blood between him and the Hallman family, but ties higher than blood. He is glad we are living under the banner of King Edward, under the laws of liberty that give freedom of worship according to the dictates of conscience. He cordially congratulated the committee on the success of its work, and resumed his seat.

"Rev. Wendell Hallman offered up thanks, and then a beautiful selection 'Steal Away Home,' was sung by Messrs Garfield Hallman, J. R. Hallman, Cassel, Jacob A. Hallman and M. E. Shantz.

"The chairman related how he had been on the spot where the old ancestor had lived. Waterloo County people would not think the land much good. He had also seen the old Lutheran church of which old Anthony Hallman had been a warden 150 years ago.

"An interesting historical sketch was outlined by Rev. H. S. Hallman, who had this work in hand. History shows that the family has been a moral one. Anthony Hallman was a member of the Lutheran church, and one of its church wardens when he died at the age of 88. All the ancestors had lived to a ripe old age. Although they may not all have been moral people, they were, so far as he was able to learn, all church attendants. There were no skeptics among them. Though the Hallman family cannot boast of being any too good, one need not be—and he is not ashamed of it. The majority of the Hallmans have been engaged in farming. His grandfather, Benjamin Hallman, used to tell of the hardships of pioneer life, when wheat had to be teamed from here to Dundas. "All honor to their resting dust to-day," said he. Almost all the callings and occupations of life are represented in the Hallman descendants.

"Mr. Elias Hallman, general secretary of the re-union, read a well wishing letter from George Hallman, of Deloraine, Manitoba. He read a statement of the expenses incurred in the reunion. It totalled \$113.07, \$70 being for the dinner for the day. A collection was taken to help defray expenses.

"A vocal selection by Mr. and Mrs. Jacob A. Hallman, Mrs. George Schlee, Miss Schlee and her brother was sung, and then the veteran, Wendell Hallman, closed with a few words of admonition to his people to discharge well the trust reposed in them; and then closed with a benediction.

"By six o'clock the grounds were well nigh deserted."
