

THE CHOLERA IN PARIS.

PROPOSED FINANCIAL REFORM IN RUSSIA.

The redistribution bill—Progress of the Russian Campaign—France and China—Other foreign news.

PARIS, Nov. 8.—Thirty-seven fresh cases of cholera in Paris yesterday and twelve deaths. In view of the small proportion of deaths the doctors believe that the epidemic is not likely to spread. To-day 70 fresh cases and 8 deaths.

Cambronne, prefect of the police department of the Seine, told the council of the department yesterday that the cholera had appeared at Aubervilliers in July, and that 100 deaths had occurred there, but that the progress of the disease was checked this time by energetic measures promptly taken.

He expressed the hope that the same measures would produce a happy result in Paris at this juncture. The morning journals say to-day that since June 20 there have been 100 cases of cholera in Paris, 50 of which proved fatal.

The epidemic campaign. WARD HATZLA, Nov. 8.—The great case of the second catarrh has been closed. Owing to low water in the river Nile all boats will be portaged around the catarrh.

An Arab, arrived at Dongola from Khartoum by the way of Shendi and Ambok, says water and fodder for the cattle are plentiful on the route. The mahdi is engaged in a campaign to drive the British out of the Sudan.

Lord Wolseley telegraphs that the mahdi with a small following was reported to be at Korthambat, north of Khartoum, whether he went after the fight at Anderman. All of the Kababseh tribe have deserted him.

The British Sabkha trade. LONDON, Nov. 8.—In the commons to-day Martini, liberal, offered resolutions, with the approval of the conservative leaders, which were laid upon the table, providing for the suspension of the sinking fund, which is devoted to paying off the national debt, for two years, and placing the amount, \$60,000,000, at the disposal of the admiralty board for the increase of the navy.

The proposal received the support of many liberals upon the ground that there is immediate necessity for strengthening the English fleet, and that the adoption of these resolutions would render additional taxation unnecessary.

Financial Reform in Austria. VIENNA, Nov. 8.—Dunajewski, minister of finance, has prepared a measure to be submitted to the Reichsrath which, if adopted, will result in the resumption of cash payments on a gold basis throughout Austria and Hungary.

The measure includes the resumption of the measure their indentments and currencies. A loan of \$250,000,000 will be raised through a German and Austrian syndicate, which will withdraw one-half the notes now in circulation, and assimilate the old currency with the German currency.

Redistribution of Parliamentary Seats. LONDON, Nov. 8.—The cabinet has been unable to agree on a plan for the redistribution of parliamentary seats, and refused the draft of the scheme recently published by the ministerial committee for amendment.

LIBERALISM. Liberal members of parliament outside the cabinet are actively conferring with leaders of the opposition on the subject of a reform bill.

France and China. PARIS, Nov. 8.—A despatch from Gen. Briere de Lisle, dated Nov. 7, says the Chinese have made a fresh attack on Tayen Quad. They were easily repulsed.

A despatch from the Chinese dated Kiating, Nov. 7, says that the Chinese had attacked the fortified works commanding the road to Tamsui, but had been repulsed with heavy loss after three hours fighting.

Albert Edward's Birthday Celebrated. LONDON, Nov. 8.—The anniversary of the Prince of Wales' birthday (he was born on November 9, 1841) was celebrated with the usual festivities to-day as is customary on the actual date happens to be Sunday. The church bells have been ringing and salutes of artillery fired at various points.

Strengthening the British Navy. LONDON, Nov. 8.—The admiralty board has ordered the construction of four torpedo cruisers and a number of torpedo boats for service at all important ports and in the British colonies.

An Informer Poisoned. MOSCOW, Nov. 8.—Rozoff, who denounced to the police many of his fellow students as saboteurs, has been poisoned in prison, where he was kept for safety.

A Gunboat for the Sale of Spain. LONDON, Nov. 8.—A gunboat with masts and polemen on board is expected to reach the Isle of Sky next Tuesday.

THE NEW U. S. CONGRESS. Republican Gains in Senate—Democratic Loss in House.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 8.—The whole number of United States senators is 76. As the senate now stands there are 39 republicans, 26 democrats and one vacancy.

The next senate will probably have 41 republicans and 35 democrats. The present house contains 121 republicans, 17 democrats and three independent; and there are four vacancies. The latest returns indicate that there have been elected for the next house 180 republicans and 175 democrats.

B., says The feeling of anxiety which has existed here for several days past regarding the presidential election gave place to one of intense satisfaction when it was learned that Governor Cleveland was elected. Each resident was eagerly desired; but in the face of the overwhelming odds, few thought it would be accomplished.

He thought the poison was arsenic, but it was discovered to-day that it was animal poison generated in the cheese itself.

A Great Parallel—Beet Sugar and Steel

The Globe has discovered what it calls a "steel with diamonds"

The steel is sold to Canadian buyers in competition with English rails

It is argued that the "high taxation policy cannot secure higher wages to the wage-earner"

Vessels of other nations, or some of them, were liable to capture, and British merchants were making immense profits in a trade which was all monopoly and no competition

The autocrat of the continent therefore issued his decree, closing against British vessels all the ports under his control, from the German coast away

round the Mediterranean

About this time, scientific men had shown that sugar, perfectly pure and chemically the same as cane sugar, could be produced from the beet root

Napoleon put the scientific discovery and political circumstances of the time together, and determined that what political power could do to aid industrial production should be done

Costly experiments were conducted at the expense of the state, and prizes or bounties were offered on a liberal scale

In these days of the weak beginnings of what is now a strong and gigantic industry, three or four pounds of cane sugar, it admitted free of customs duties and the risks of war, might have been obtained for what it cost to produce one pound of beet sugar

It was, except under very high protection, the production of beet sugar on the large scale would never have a beginning at all, for private individuals certainly would not go on selling for a shilling what it had cost them two or three shillings to produce

But Napoleon, who was enough of an economist to know that in this case half measures would be useless, went the length of not high protection merely, but of prohibition as far as his armies were able to enforce it

And his plan was heartily supported, not only in France, but outside of France too, by many persons, who, while detesting his political rule, were rejoiced to see the promise of a large and profitable industry for all future time which was sootier than the trade of the sea

After his fall the seas were clear and the ports were open, but by that time the value and importance of the new industry had been so well demonstrated that the governments of France and other countries continued to protect it by high duties; and thus Napoleon's policy with regard to sugar was adopted as the permanent commercial policy of continental Europe

Here we have, on the record of history, a very clear case of an industry, of immense national importance brought into life and made to grow great and strong, and all through protection undisturbingly applied and long continued

We do not find much of this remarkable chapter of industrial history in free trade text books, but the reason why lies on the surface

Now, the rise of the steel rail manufacture during the last twelve years in the United States, and the reduction in price from \$120 to \$28 per ton, is in its essential points just another story

To the old production of cane sugar in hot countries was hanging on the chance of a few hundred sugar in the temperate climate of Europe
