



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# LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, 25th August, 1852.

Ordered,—That it shall be the duty of the Clerk to make and cause to be printed, and delivered to each Member, at the commencement of every Session of the Legislature, a List of the Reports or other periodical Statements which it is the duty of any Officer or Department of the Government, or any Bank or other corporate body, to make to the Legislative Assembly, referring to the Act or Resolution, and page of the volume of the Laws or Journals in which it may be contained, and placing under the name of each Officer or Corporation, a List of Reports or Returns required of him or it to be made, and the time when the Report or periodical Statement may be expected. (Journal of 1852-3, p. 23.)

#### MEMORANDUM.

In carrying into effect the foregoing Order, it was found, upon an examination of the Statutes, that many Reports and Returns of a similar nature to those therein referred to, were required to be made, by various Officers or Corporations, to the Governor only, such Returns being (it is presumed) intended for the information of the Legislature, but obtainable only by addressing His Excellency;—a Supplementary List of these Reports has accordingly been made, and attached to the Return herewith presented.

The Lists now laid before the House having been compiled from the Statutes, it is not improbable that some of the incorporated Companies included therein may have ceased to exist, but as this cannot be correctly ascertained without accurate local information, Members will confer a favor by calling the attention of the Clerk to any such cases coming within their own knowledge.
