Well ripened cream has pleasant acid taste, and is of an even tick consistency, 16 to 20 hours is suffi-ent for the process. Churing should be me as often as practicable. It is im-possible to lay down any set rule as to mperature, as this varies a good deal cording to local conditions, the tem-rature, however, which will cause the itter to come in 30 to 40 minutes may successfully adopted.
