PROF. ROBERTSON LECTURES ON PROPER BREAD AND BUTTER.

Conditions which are necessary for the Growth of Man—Oatmeal and Potatoes—Interesting Particulars.

Prof. Robertson, Superintendent of the Dairy Department of the Dominion Experimental Farm at Ottawa, who is now in the Province, delivered a very interesting lecture on 'Bread and Butter in Victoria' last Thursday evening, there being present a considerable number of well-known and prominent citizens. Dr. Milne, President of the B. C. Agricultural Association, occupied the chair. The lecturer gave the following resume of the lecture: He introduced the topic by referring to the fact that whenever a small boy dropped his slice of bread or butter it always fell on the buttered side. Now, as a matter of fact, it did not always fall on the buttered side. It has happened frequently and generally it was just the reverse. He remembered the unucky times and forgot the many times that his slice of bread and butter had escaped injury. The belief arose that the buttered side always falls down. So many men, in all our progress as a nation, were apt to recall all the unucky things that happened to get our success. Proper bread and butter conditions were necessary for the proper growth of a man. The bread starved, improperly nourished boy became a criminal, whereas the well-nourished child was more favorably developed as an individual. The Prof. told a couple of stories. He had mixed up families of pigs and found that those of the same family which were fed on a balanced food were good natured, the ill-nourished ones were quarrelsome and were sickly men. By an oatmeal bun a simple method how butter was concentrated, showing how butter was concentrated by showing progressively on a sheet how concentrated butter was the germination of the seed which grew into a normal plant. The bread and butter was finally made into butter. 'Find me a people,' he said, 'that are poorly nourished and I will show you a people that are not good for much.'
